Good Evening HSMC Family!

Thank you for continuing along with us on our 2020-2021 school-year journey. It continues to be our intention to keep you updated via weekly news updates, school website postings and updates to our social media. In each of these updates I will provide the most recent information related to our COVID19 response. Today was our first day of in-person/blended classes. Thank you for working with us during this transition. Over the next few weeks we will be working toward preparing students to register for college courses for Summer and Fall 2021. The registration date (for both summer and fall) for HSMC students is Thursday, April 29, 2021. Please check your myvcccd portal to confirm your registration date and time. HSMC Counselors/Administrators will be scheduling individual education plan meetings with all 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students prior to their registration. These meetings will be on April 12<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, and 21<sup>st</sup>. At these meeting we will discuss individual course options, long-term academic goals, and make decisions about which courses a student should register for. We will also provide specific, direct instructions for how to select courses, complete and submit appropriate forms, and confirm your registration after completion.

Finally, please remember that “end-of-year-activities” are not yet finalized as we continue to work directly with Moorpark College, Moorpark Unified, and Ventura County Public Health on appropriate versions of these events. With that said, we can confirm that we will be holding a modified/socially distanced **Prom on Wednesday, May 12<sup>th</sup>**. More information will follow this week with tickets going on sale next week. Our plans for awards ceremonies and graduation are not yet finalized. It is most likely that we will be holding both a virtual and a socially-distanced/in-person event on separate days. **Our Virtual Awards/Graduation ceremony will take place on May 25. If we are able to have an in-person ceremony the same evening (5/25) we will do so. We do not yet have final confirmation of our date(s), but should have everything confirmed by Monday, April 12.** More details will follow as they become available.

- **Attention Seniors**
  - Congrats to many of you who have received acceptance into colleges all over the USA and beyond! You are all amazing students and deserve to attend the college of your dreams!!! Unfortunately space does not permit the colleges to accept everyone - so please do not take non acceptance as a failure - but merely a campus space issue!
  - May 1st is the Freshman SIR Deadline to let colleges know that you intend to attend their university!
  - Accepting a UC admission offer
    - Students can accept an admission offer by agreeing to the provisions/conditions outlined in the offer and submitting their Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) with the SIR deposit to reserve their space at a campus. The SIR deposit is \$250. Some important things to keep in mind about accepting a UC admission offer:
      - Students can accept only one admission offer from one UC campus.
      - The SIR deposit is applied to the student's first enrollment term tuition.
      - Students that qualified for the UC application fee waiver will have the SIR deposit deferred until financial aid is disbursed.
      - The SIR deposit is nonrefundable and non-transferable.
      - A Statement of Legal Residence (SLR) for tuition determination purposes may be required.
  - For students attending a UC: You may need to take an AWPE Exam on May 22nd - Please check your portals for guidance and instructions.
  - For students attending Moorpark College in the Fall: May 3rd is Registration Rocks 2:30-4:45 PM

- **PLEASE DO NOT JUST “DROP BY” THE HSMC CAMPUS.** Our office is closed unless you have an appointment. Please call or email Ms. Gaeta to schedule a time to meet on campus. **Visitors will now be required to go through checkpoints at the College even if they are just picking up/dropping off.** The closest checkpoint will be by the Child Development Center on Campus Dr, just past the turn they would normally take to get to HS@MC. They will need to have the VCCCD app downloaded on their smartphone and select "visitor" in order to take the pre-screen survey. They will need to leave their device on the "Clear to be on campus" screen at the end of the survey and show that to the attendant at the checkpoint in order to get an all clear health pass on the app as well as a colored wristband(color will vary by day).
- Parents/Guardians **MUST** call us at (805)378-6312 ext. 7293 to report tardies or absences within 48 hours, 72 hours on Fridays or holidays (even students that are 18 or over, while they are attending HS@MC they are still considered a K-12 student and must have parent/guardian report for them for attendance purposes). Per District policy emails cannot be used.

**On-Campus COVID19 Rules/Procedures**

- 1. If You Have Tested Positive**
  - a. Immediately notify the school at 805-378-6312
  - b. Do not return in person until meeting the criteria that will be directly communicated by the district nurse and/or school personnel
- 2. If You Have Any Symptom of COVID19**
  - a. Immediately notify the school at 805-378-6312
  - b. Do not return in person until meeting the criteria that will be directly communicated by the district nurse and/or school personnel
- 3. If You Are Identified as a Close Contact to a COVID19 Positive Individual**
  - a. Immediately notify the school at 805-378-6312
  - b. Do not return in person until meeting the criteria that will be directly communicated by the district nurse and/or school personnel
- 4. If Someone in Your Household Has Symptom(s) of COVID19**
  - a. Immediately notify the school at 805-378-6312
  - b. Do not return in person until meeting the criteria that will be directly communicated by the district nurse and/or school personnel
- 5. Entering Campus**
  - a. All persons entering the Moorpark College campus must use the myvcccd app to complete a “prescreening” before getting out of their vehicle
  - b. All persons entering campus must proceed directly to the check-in station before going anywhere else on campus.
    - i. At this station, we will:
      1. check the results of the myvcccd app prescreening,
      2. ask follow-up questions related to COVID symptoms,
      3. take your temperature with a no-touch thermometer
    - ii. If you are clear to come to campus after completing the following, you will be issued a wristband in the days’ color to wear for the remainder of your time on campus. This wristband indicates to MC/HSMC employees that you are supposed to be on campus and have been cleared through the check-in process
  - c. You will scan the barcode for the classroom you enter using the myvcccd app.
- 6. Potential COVID19 Symptoms Include:**
  - a. Fever or Chills
  - b. Cough
  - c. Shortness of breath or Difficulty breathing
  - d. Fatigue
  - e. Muscle or body aches
  - f. Headache
  - g. New loss of taste or smell
  - h. Sore throat
  - i. Congestion or runny nose
  - j. Nausea or vomiting
  - k. Diarrhea
- 7. Exhibiting Symptoms after checking in**
  - a. If at any time you begin to exhibit any symptoms related to illness, immediately tell your teacher who will contact the office where we will provide immediate instructions.
- 8. Visitors**
  - a. The campus is only open for those authorized to be here – the office is NOT open for drop-in appointments or questions. Please call and schedule an appointment if you intend to be on campus outside of your authorized times
- 9. Physical Distancing**





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- a. All individuals on campus must maintain at least 6 feet of distance between themselves and others at all times

**10. Masks**

- a. Masks/Face Coverings are required on the Moorpark College campus at all times.

**11. Restroom use**

- a. Restroom use will be limited to one student at a time
- b. Please check that the sign indicates “VACANT” before entering the restroom
  - i. If a restroom is “OCCUPIED” please wait until it is “VACANT” to enter.
    1. If you have waited a significant amount of time for an “OCCUPIED” restroom, knock on the outer door to confirm the sign is correct
- c. When you enter the restroom, change the sign to “OCCUPIED”
- d. When you finish using the restroom, wash your hands with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds
- e. When you leave the restroom, change the sign to “VACANT”
- f. Return to your classroom

**12. Food and Drink**

- a. Food and drink are not allowed indoors on the Moorpark College campus.
- b. If you will be eating or drinking on campus
  - i. During Class-time
    1. Ask the teacher if you may go outside to eat/drink
    2. find a location at least 6 feet from any other individual
    3. eat/drink as required
    4. return to class
  - ii. During Lunch-time
    1. If you are not eating, you may stay in your classroom or go outside
    2. If you are eating, you must go outside
      - a. find a location at least 6 feet from any other individual
      - b. there will be markers on the ground to indicate distance
      - c. eat/drink as required
      - d. return to class

**13. Sharing Items**

- a. Students must use only their own items at all times; no sharing of items between students is allowed

**14. Other Healthy Practices**

- a. Avoid contact with eyes, nose, mouth
- b. Cover coughs and sneezes
- c. Wash hands for at least 20 seconds with soap and warm water

**15. DROP OFF**

- a. No earlier than 9:30 for 9<sup>th</sup> grade, 8:30 for 10<sup>th</sup> grade, 12:30 for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
- b. If you are late to drop off, please contact the office before arriving at 805-378-6312

**16. PICK UP**

- a. 1PM -2PM for 9<sup>th</sup> grade, 1PM – 2PM for 10<sup>th</sup> grade, 5:30 PM for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade
- b. If you require early pick up, please contact the office before arriving at 805-378-6312

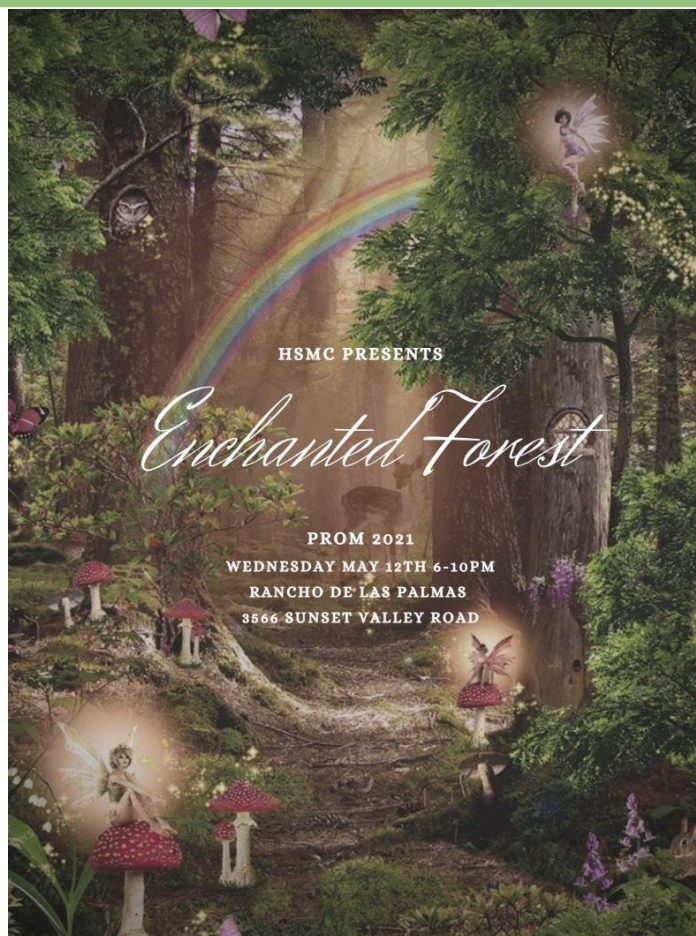
