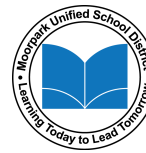

Good Evening HSMC Family!

Thank you for continuing along with us on our 2020-2021 school-year journey. It continues to be our intention to keep you updated via weekly news updates, school website postings and updates to our social media. In each of these updates I will provide the most recent information related to our COVID19 response. At this point, cases have been consistently declining accross Ventura County and while our county indicator remains “in the purple,” it appears as though we will soon be “in the red.”

We will be returning to a blended schedule for those who indicated that as their preference on our most recent survey beginning on Monday, April 5. For those families who have chosen to remain distance-only, nothing will change for your student and they will complete the school year with the same schedule they have had so far this semester. We will be holding mandatory information sessions in late March to explain all of the pertinent details for your student’s return (either distance or blended).

If you have chosen “blended,” the days your student will be assigned to be in-person will be dependent on the final results of this survey, school-wide. Our plans will be developed based on the number of responses in each category. A blended student will attend classes in person 2 days per week and at a distance 3 days per week. How this information will specifically relate to your student will be explained in the late-March mandatory meeting.

Additionally, MUSD is proud to launch a new virtual wellness center. This is a website designed to support the well-being of staff, students and parents as well as connect them to calming activities and tools to promote health and wellness. This is a safe space to access support, take a break, rest and refocus. This wellness center is a result of a collaboration between Moorpark Unified School district, Ventura County Office of Education, and Ventura County Behavioral Health through the Mental Health Services Act grant. The intent of this site is to provide outreach and a space for students and families to access mental health resources especially during distance learning. This is intended to enhance current counseling and mental health supports within the district. The virtual wellness center can be accessed through Moorpark’s home page at www.mrpk.org and on each of the school site webpages.

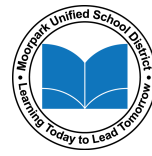

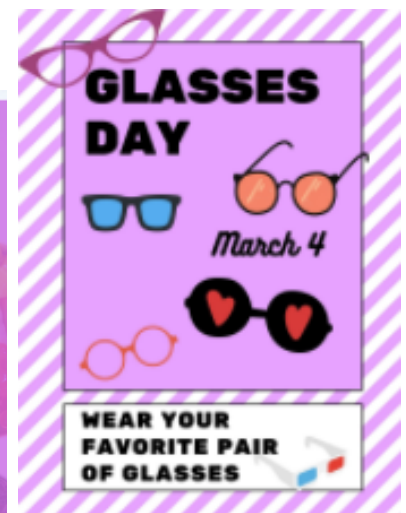

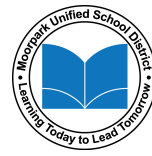
- **Yogurtland Fundraiser March 24th**

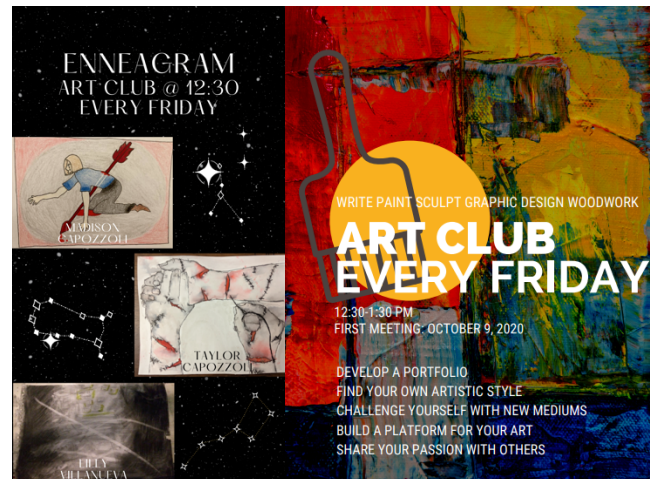




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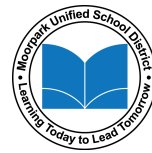


- **Pennies for Patients Fundraiser has surpassed our goal!**

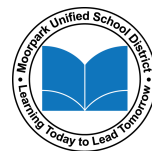

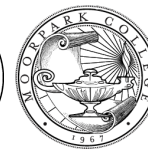

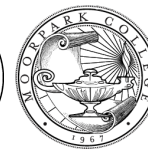
- Moorpark College Career Week is this week March 1st-5th.

- **PLEASE DO NOT JUST “DROP BY” THE HSMC CAMPUS.** Our office is closed unless you have an appointment. Please call or email Ms. Gaeta to schedule a time to meet on campus. **Visitors will now be required to go through checkpoints at the College even if they are just picking up/dropping off.** The closest checkpoint will be by the Child Development Center on Campus Dr, just past the turn they would normally take to get to HS@MC. They will need to have the VCCCD app downloaded on their smartphone and select "visitor" in order to take the pre-screen survey. They will need to leave their device on the "Clear to be on campus" screen at the end of the survey and show that to the attendant at the checkpoint in order to get an all clear health pass on the app as well as a colored wristband(color will vary by day).
- Parents/Guardians **MUST** call us at (805)378-6312 ext. 7293 to report tardies or absences within 48 hours, 72 hours on Fridays or holidays (even students that are 18 or over, while they are attending HS@MC they are still considered a K-12 student and must have parent/guardian report for them for attendance purposes). Per District policy emails cannot be used.
- The Moorpark Unified School District Technology Office is providing support to our MUSD families with a technology support hotline which can be reached at **(805) 517-2100**. Live support will be available from 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM Monday through Friday. Please be aware this IT number is only for technical issues with our Chromebooks.

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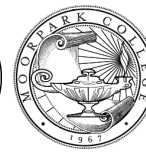

Dear Moorpark Families,

Moorpark Unified School District has selected GoGuardian services to help students stay safe, engaged, on task, and focused while learning online. GoGuardian's web-based services operate on District managed Google Suite for Education Chrome accounts when a student is logged into an MUSD issued Chromebook.

There are three components of the GoGuardian Suite: GoGuardian Admin, Teacher and Parent.

GoGuardian Admin: Helps protect students from harmful content 24/7.

GoGuardian Parent App: Enables parental controls over District issued devices. Parents may set their own internet controls during non-school hours by using [Getting Started with GoGuardian Parent](#). When a student is off campus, parents are responsible for supervising internet access and usage. We encourage parents to discuss rules for appropriate internet usage with their student, and reinforce lessons of digital citizenship and safety. [VCOE Digital Citizenship Resources](#) are available to assist. We also highly encourage parents to report any potential cyberbullying or other sensitive issues to the school principal.

GoGuardian Teacher: Provides teachers with the ability to regulate student devices, send messages, offer individualized support, and view student screens during class. Teacher access only works during school hours from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Students are to use their school-managed Google accounts and school-managed devices for educational purposes as outlined in [Moorpark Unified School District Student Acceptable Use Policy](#).
