Good Evening HSMC Family!

Thank you for continuing along with us on our 2020-2021 school-year journey. It continues to be our intention to keep you updated via weekly news updates, school website postings and updates to our social media. In each of these updates I will provide the most recent information related to our COVID19 response. This Friday, February 12, and Monday, February 15 are celebrated as recess days for the President's Day Holiday for both high school and college courses. You will not have high school courses on either of these days. Please confirm with your college professors that you do not have college courses.

At this point, cases continue to rise in Ventura County and our county indicator remains in "the purple." **At this point, it is our intention to remain DISTANCE-ONLY at least through April 2 (the end of our Spring Break).** We intend to return under our blended model when we return for the fourth quarter in Early April. Certainly, things can change between now and then, and I will keep you updated as to the nature of those changes.

Below, you will find the link to an updated survey to indicate your preference for your student if/when we move to a blended return. This survey will be similar to what you were asked in July, but we would like to gather updated data as people's choices may have changed since then. If you have not already, please complete this survey as soon as possible for us to be able to build a schedule that accommodates all of our families' desires.

- If you chose the "distance learning model" nothing will change for your student and they will complete the school year with the same schedule they have had so far this semester.
- If you chose the "blended learning model" your student will attend classes at a distance multiple days per week, and in person on other days.
  - The days your student will be assigned to be in-person will be dependent on the final results of this survey, school-wide. Our plans will be developed based on the number of responses in each category. The most likely outcome is that a blended student will attend classes in person 2 days per week and at a distance 3 days per week.
- It is our intention to have final cohorts and schedules to all students/families before we leave for spring break.

Exotic Animal Training & Management (EATM)	The EATM program offers preparation for students interested in entering the expanding animal care industry. The increasing importance of zoos and wildlife education to the efforts of conservation, as well as the use of animals in various entertainment fields, present many career options to graduates of this curriculum. Students in this demo will learn about the program and catch a glimpse of the college's on-site zoo, which is home to a wide variety of animals.	Sessions 1 & 3
Film, Television, & Media Arts (FTMA)	The FTMA program prepares students for careers in educational and commercial radio, television, and film production. Related careers include Film and Television Producers, Film and Television Directors, Film and Video Editors, Camera Operators for Television and Motion Pictures, and Broadcast Technicians. Kinesiology (Exercise Science)	Kinesiology is the study of the mechanics of body movements, and exercise science is the study of how the body reacts and adapts to a variety of stresses. MakerSpace	Moorpark College has three MakerSpaces, which are part of a growing movement across the country to support creativity and entrepreneurship. MakerSpaces house the tools and technology which allow students to realize their ideas as they create objects of function and beauty.	Sessions 1, 2, & 3
Music Technology	The Music Technology program prepares students for a wide variety of careers in the music industry. Professional musician, composer, recording artist, music production assistant, and audio technician, are just a few examples of possible work that awaits students who complete this program. Radiologic Technology	Radiologic Technology is the art and science of using radiation to provide images of bones, internal organs, soft tissue and vessels that comprise the human body. These images are digitally recorded and used as a tool to diagnose disease, injury, or congenital deformity. Successful completion of the Moorpark College Associate of Science Degree in Radiologic Technology qualifies a student to take the professional licensing examination to become a registered Radiologic Technologist. Photovoltaic Technology	The Photovoltaic Technology program is designed for students who would like to develop the skills needed to work as solar technicians.
