#### Good Evening HSMC Family!

Thank you for continuing along with us on our 2020-2021 school-year journey. As we enter February it is important to recognize and celebrate Black History Month. Additionally, February 1 - February 5 is School Counselors Week. Help me say thank you to Mrs. McIntosh and Mrs. Reyes!

It continues to be our intention to keep you updated via weekly news updates, school website postings and updates to our social media. In each of these updates I will provide the most recent information related to our COVID19 response. At this point, cases continue to rise in Ventura County and our county indicator remains in "the purple." At this point, it is our intention to remain DISTANCE-ONLY at least through April 2 (the end of our Spring Break). We intend to return under our blended model when we return for the fourth quarter in Early April. Certainly, things can change between now and then, and I will keep you updated as to the nature of those changes.

This survey will be similar to what you were asked in July, but we would like to gather updated data as people's choices may have changed since then. Please complete this survey within the next week for us to be able to build a schedule that accommodates all of our families' desires.

- If you chose the "distance learning model" nothing will change for your student and they will complete the school year with the same schedule they have had so far this semester.
- If you chose the "blended learning model" your student will attend classes at a distance multiple days per week, and in person on other days.
  - The days your student will be assigned to be in-person will be dependent on the final results of this survey, school-wide. Our plans will be developed based on the number of responses in each category. The most likely outcome is that a blended student will attend classes in person 2 days per week and at a distance 3 days per week.
- It is our intention to have final cohorts and schedules to all students/families before we leave for spring break at the end of March.







#### FAFSA

O The California Student Aid Commission uncovered a startling statistic this month. Data shows FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) completions are down by 12% among graduating high school students and California Dream Act Application (CADAA) completions are down 19%. Most financial aid is contingent on filing a FAFSA or California Dream Act Application.

#### Cal Grant

March 2 deadline to submit applications for the Cal Grant. The Cal Grant offers free money for California students attending a California community college, UC, CSU, or a fully online or independent, non-profit university. We encourage students and parents to attend one of the upcoming virtual Cash for College workshops led by professionals and often hosted by community colleges. The workshops provide resources and individualized support for filling out financial aid forms. #### Moorpark College First Year Experience program

- This year, the First-Year Experience program (formerly the Guided Pathway to Success Program) welcomed more 1st-year students than ever before and continues to walk alongside students in support of their first foray into college life. There is also a new Second Year Experience program that will allow for this support to continue!
- O Students should sign up between January and May 2021 for entry into the 2021-2022 program.
- This program remains 100% free and comes with Student Success Coaches assigned to students that act as mentors, listeners, and support students' affective domain as they traverse college pathways.
- o Students are partnered with dedicated Academic Support Counselors who regularly check in with and help guide students.
- o This program is a wonderful opportunity for students to be part of a community at MC, and they can get the true university experience while they attend community college.

#### Free Confidence Building Podcast

- The GoZen! Stories podcast launches tomorrow (2/2) and is totally free! The first season, called Kid Confident, is about a high school freshman named Kacey who struggles with confidence, friendships, and belonging. With some help from the mysterious Kid Confident, Kacey learns the skills to transform her anxiety into courage and confidence.






# **Front Office News**

- PLEASE DO NOT JUST "DROP BY" THE HSMC CAMPUS. Our office is closed unless you have an appointment. Please call or email Ms. Gaeta to schedule a time to meet on campus. Visitors will now be required to go through checkpoints at the College even if they are just picking up/dropping off. The closest checkpoint will be by the Child Development Center on Campus Dr, just past the turn they would normally take to get to HS@MC. They will need to have the VCCCD app downloaded on their smartphone and select "visitor" in order to take the pre-screen survey. They will need to leave their device on the "Clear to be on campus" screen at the end of the survey and show that to the attendant at the checkpoint in order to get an all clear health pass on the app as well as a colored wristband(color will vary by day).
- Parents/Guardians MUST call us at (805)378-6312 ext. 7293 to report tardies or absences within 48 hours, 72 hours on Fridays or holidays (even students that are 18 or over, while they are attending HS@MC they are still considered a K-12 student and must have parent/guardian report for them for attendance purposes). Per District policy emails cannot be used.
