Thank you for continuing along with us on our 2020-2021 school-year journey. You have my continued gratitude for all of your support and flexibility as we continue through January and the beginning of the second semester. It continues to be our intention to keep you updated via weekly news updates, school website postings and updates to our social media. Today is the first day of college courses. There is no school (either college or high school) on Monday, January 18 in observation of the Martin Luther King Jr. holiday.

In each of these updates I will provide the most recent information related to our COVID19 response. At this point, cases continue to rise in Ventura County and our county indicator remains in "the purple." At this point, it is our intention to remain DISTANCE-ONLY at least through March 12 (the end of our 3rd academic quarter). We intend to return under our blended model when we return for the fourth quarter in Late March/Early April. Certainly, things can change between now and March, and I will keep you updated as to the nature of those changes. In the coming weeks we will be sending a new survey to ascertain the potential plans for students and families as it relates to distance and blended education for our fourth quarter.







- PLEASE DO NOT JUST "DROP BY" THE HSMC CAMPUS. Our office is closed unless you have an appointment. Please call or email Ms. Gaeta to schedule a time to meet on campus. Visitors will now be required to go through checkpoints at the College even if they are just picking up/dropping off. The closest checkpoint will be by the Child Development Center on Campus Dr, just past the turn they would normally take to get to HS@MC. They will need to have the VCCCD app downloaded on their smartphone and select "visitor" in order to take the pre-screen survey. They will need to leave their device on the "Clear to be on campus" screen at the end of the survey and show that to the attendant at the checkpoint in order to get an all clear health pass on the app as well as a colored wristband(color will vary by day).
- Parents/Guardians MUST call us at (805)378-6312 ext. 7293 to report tardies or absences within 48 hours, 72 hours on Fridays or holidays (even students that are 18 or over, while they are attending HS@MC they are still considered a K-12 student and must have parent/guardian report for them for attendance purposes). Per District policy emails cannot be used.
