Good Evening,

Thank you for continuing along with us on our 2020-2021 school-year journey. You have my continued gratitude for all of your support and flexibility as we enter the final two weeks of 2020. It continues to be our intention to keep you updated via weekly news updates, school website postings and updates to our social media. In each of these updates I will provide the most recent information related to our COVID19 response. At this point, cases continue to rise in Ventura County and our county indicator remains in "the purple." At this point, it is our intention to remain DISTANCE-ONLY at least through March 12 (the end of our 3rd academic quarter). We intend to return under our blended model when we return for the fourth quarter in Late March/Early April. Certainly, things can change between now and March, and I will keep you updated as to the nature of those changes.

The weather calls for strong wind over the next few weeks. Please see page 2 of this document for MUSD Power Outage Protocols. All students should now be registered for Moorpark College Courses for Spring 2021. If you are not registered or need help please contact our main office. We will be holding our next information session for transfers/applicants (for all grade levels) on Thursday, December 10th at 6PM via Google Meet. If you know anyone who is interested in attending HSMC, please share our information session information with them and ask them to sign-up on our website <u>www.hsmc.mrpk.org</u>. We have openings at all grade levels for both Spring 2021 and Fall 2021.

Finally, as we approach the end of the first semester, there are some important details related to our calendar. Picture day is tentatively scheduled for the afternoon on Thursday, December 17th (SEE DETAILS ON PAGE 10). The first semester officially ends for HIGH SCHOOL COURSES on Friday, December 18th. The first semester officially ends for COLLEGE COURSES on Wednesday, December 16th. College finals will take place between December 10th and December 16th. High School finals/summative assessments will conclude on December 18th. Our Winter Break begins on Saturday, December 19th and concludes on Tuesday, January 5th. Our first day of HIGH SCHOOL COURSES for the SECOND SEMSTER is Wednesday, January 6th. The first day of COLLEGE COURSES for the SECOND SEMESTER is Monday, January 11th. Second semester course schedules will be sent to grade-level cohorts later this week.

Protocols for Google Meet/Internet Connectivity Issues

Secondary

Scenario 1: Internet goes down in the middle of a Google Meet

Follow any directions given to you by your teacher, then do the following:

- 1. Stay on for the first 5 minutes.
- 2. After 5 minutes, log out and log back in.
- 3. If you are still unable to log in to the Google Meet, wait until the next ½ hour increment on the half hour or hour (:00 or :30) and try again. Begin working on long-term class projects, review prior class session notes and/or complete any other unfinished assignments. Check Canvas for teacher instruction.
- 4. If you are still unable to login, continue to work on long-term class projects, review prior class session notes and/or complete any other unfinished assignments for the remainder of the class period.
- 5. Make sure to turn in any work done during the missed class time, so that you can be given credit for attending.

Scenario 2: Teacher internet goes down/ Google Meet isn't available and/or you are unable to access it

- 1. If you are unable to access the Google Meet at the designated class start time, try again in 5 minutes.
- 2. If you are still unable to access the Google Meet wait until the next ½ hour increment on the half hour or hour (:00 or :30) and try again. Work on long-term class projects, review prior class session notes and/or complete any other unfinished assignments for the remainder of the class period. Check Canvas for teacher instruction.
- 3. Make sure to turn in any work done during the missed class time, so that you can be given credit for attending and email teacher to let him/her know that you were unable to join the Google Meet.





College Application Information:


- To better serve high school and community college students facing university admissions challenges caused by COVID-19, the California State University (CSU) will extend its fall 2021 priority application deadline to December 15, 2020 at 11:59 PM PST. The Cal State Apply Support hours have been extended as well.
- We do encourage applications to be submitted as soon as possible.
- If student and their family have experienced a significant change in income they may qualify for an application fee waiver appeal. Fee waiver appeals are handled by the individual CSU campuses. - PLEASE DO NOT JUST "DROP BY" THE HSMC CAMPUS. Our office is closed unless you have an appointment. Please call or email Ms. Gaeta to schedule a time to meet on campus. Visitors will now be required to go through checkpoints at the College even if they are just picking up/dropping off. The closest checkpoint will be by the Child Development Center on Campus Dr, just past the turn they would normally take to get to HS@MC. They will need to have the VCCCD app downloaded on their smartphone and select "visitor" in order to take the pre-screen survey. They will need to leave their device on the "Clear to be on campus" screen at the end of the survey and show that to the attendant at the checkpoint in order to get an all clear health pass on the app as well as a colored wristband(color will vary by day).
- Parents/Guardians MUST call us at (805)378-6312 ext. 7293 to report tardies or absences within 48 hours, 72 hours on Fridays or holidays (even students that are 18 or over, while they are attending HS@MC they are still considered a K-12 student and must have parent/guardian report for them for attendance purposes). Per District policy emails cannot be used.
