Good Evening,

Thank you for continuing along with us on our 2020-2021 school-year journey. You have my continued gratitude for all of your support and flexibility as we begin the second quarter of the school year. It continues to be our intention to keep you updated via weekly news updates, school website postings and updates to our social media. In each of these updates I will provide the most recent information related to our COVID19 response. At this point, our academic plan is to remain distance-only through the end of the first semester (matching Moorpark College). We intend to return under our blended model when we return for the second semester on Wednesday, January 6. Certainly, things can change between now and January, and I will keep you updated as to the nature of those changes.

Registration for Spring Semester college courses will take place beginning on November 12<sup>th</sup>. Mrs. McIntosh (HSMC counselor), Mr. Hess (Moorpark College counselor), and I met with 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> grade advisory classes earlier today. We invite parents and students to join us for a Q&A session on Wednesday, October 28<sup>th</sup> at 6PM <u>meet.google.com/osg-aoam-cgh</u>. Mr. Hess will be providing drop-in college counseling services on the 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup>, and 29<sup>th</sup> of October from 12PM - 1:30 PM <u>https://cccconfer.zoom.us/my/trevorhess</u>. Individual education plan meetings will take place with Seniors, Juniors, and Sophomores during the week of November 2. I will be visiting Freshman Advisory the week of November 2 with drop in times on November 9 for any Freshman registration questions. High school course schedules for the Spring Semester will be available in December, but courses will continue to take place between 8AM and 1PM for 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students and between 1PM and 5:30PM for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students.

We will be using Jostens for our Graduation items for the class of 2021. More information about ordering caps/gowns/class rings, etc. will be sent to seniors later this week. The early bird deadline for ordering will be Friday, November 20.

Our PSSA and our School Site Council are looking for members. If you would like to nominate yourself or another member of our school community, please send me an email with the name of the person you are nominating and the organization you are nominating them to. The organizations help determine the specific plans for the High School at Moorpark College. ### **Moorpark College Free Tutoring**


- <u>The Learning Center</u> at Moorpark College offers free tutoring to all MC students.

- PLEASE DO NOT JUST "DROP BY" THE HSMC CAMPUS. Our office is closed unless you have an appointment. Please call or email Ms. Gaeta to schedule a time to meet on campus.
- Visitors will now be required to go through checkpoints at the College even if they are just picking up/dropping off. The closest checkpoint will be by the Child Development Center on Campus Dr, just past the turn they would normally take to get to HS@MC. They will need to have the VCCCD app downloaded on their smartphone and select "visitor" in order to take the pre-screen survey. They will need to leave their device on the "Clear to be on campus" screen at the end of the survey and show that to the attendant at the checkpoint in order to get an all clear health pass on the app as well as a colored wristband(color will vary by day).
- Parents/Guardians MUST call us at (805)378-6312 ext. 7293 to report tardies or absences within 48 hours, 72 hours on Fridays or holidays (even students that are 18 or over, while they are attending HS@MC they are still considered a K-12 student and must have parent/guardian report for them for attendance purposes). Per District policy emails cannot be used.
- ParentConnect pins and passwords can be provided upon request from our main office.
- The Moorpark Unified School District Technology Office is providing support to our MUSD families with a technology support hotline which can be reached at (805) 517-2100. Live support will be available from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM Monday through Friday starting Monday August 24th. Please be aware this IT number is only for technical issues with our Chromebooks.
