At this point, our academic plan is to remain in our distance learning protocol until we are given permission to move to a blended model by the State, County, and School District. We are beginning to get information that changes to our standing in the state may change soon. If and when any change occurs, I will notify you as soon as possible.

Earlier today, we had our WASC (Western Association of Schools and Colleges) virtual visit for the accreditation of our 10th grade. This required process must be completed whenever a school makes a significant change such as adding a grade level. 

Naviance has so much to offer in career exploration. If you are interested in researching careers check out your Naviance Account @ succeed.naviance.com and click on the CLEVER tab.
 Students will be automatically logged in. Presentations will be scheduled for each grade level to complete the Career Cluster Finder and Career Interest Profiler.

- o Cal State Apply opened Oct. 1 and is **Due Dec. 4th**
- o https://www2.calstate.edu/apply
- Here are some tips:
 - Set up an account with an email you will be checking regularly **NOT** your school email account. Remember your password!
 - To find HS@MC: High School at Moorpark College (CEEB Code: 052-046)
 - **Dual Enrollment** college coursework should be reported under **College Coursework Tab** and use pull down for college attended. Even if the course is on your high school transcript don't list under high school courses. Full year credit and grade bump will be automatically added.
 - Do not record Non CP Courses: i.e. Health, PE
 - Only enter 8th grade Math and World Language if meets A-G requirement
 - SAT/ACT are optional and only used for placement purposes not admission if you want to report prior tests taken.
 - If you have questions: Go to Cal State Apply **Applicant Help Center** to Live Chat
- **Financial Aid:** Oct. 1st the FAFSA Application (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is available. The spooner you turn in the better chance to earn some FREE money for college. Many private universities require that you fill it out regardless of how much income a family earns. So don't delay! Refer to your notes from Mrs. Sandoval's guest speaker in Senior Advisory.
 - o Create a Federal Student Aid (FSA) Account: https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm
 - o Gather the materials needed (Social Security number, Tax return paperwork)
 - o Fill out FAFSA application: https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa






Front Office News

- Parents/Guardians MUST call us at (805)378-6312 ext. 7293 to report tardies or absences within 48 hours, 72 hours on Fridays or holidays (even students that are 18 or over, while they are attending HS@MC they are still considered a K-12 student and must have parent/guardian report for them for attendance purposes). Per District policy emails cannot be used.
- ParentConnect pins and passwords can be provided upon request from our main office.
- Parents that would like to plan for vacations around our school calendar can visit our HS@MC website here OR request a 2020-2021 copy from our main office. Reminder: Moorpark College does not recognize recess days so students should expect to follow their class schedule for college classes as usual unless directed otherwise by their Professors. Students can review the Moorpark College calendar for more information by visiting the College website here.
- The Moorpark Unified School District Technology Office is providing support to our MUSD families with a technology support hotline which can be reached at (805) 517-2100. Live support will be available from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM Monday through Friday starting Monday August 24th. Please be aware this IT number is only for technical issues with our Chromebooks.
- Any issues with Moorpark College Canvas or ConferZoom must be directed to the Moorpark College

 such as Canvas Tutorials, a live chat box(during business hours) and an after-hours phone line for
 Moorpark College students can be found on the Student Online Support page.
- Visitors will now be required to go through checkpoints at the College even if they are just picking up/dropping off. The closest checkpoint will be by the Child Development Center on Campus Dr, just past the turn they would normally take to get to HS@MC. They will need to have the VCCCD app downloaded on their smartphone and select "visitor" in order to take the pre-screen survey. They will need to leave their device on the "Clear to be on campus" screen at the end of the survey and show that to the attendant at the checkpoint in order to get an all clear health pass on the app as well as a colored wristband(color will vary by day).
- Alternatively, we can continue to communicate by mail, email and phone. Anything mailed should be addressed to HS@MC to ensure it is placed in our inbox at the College's mailroom.
