Dear Special Recipient, Local Law Enforcement, and State Police Barracks:

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 54-258, whenever a registrant is released into the community or changes their address, the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection is required to notify the superintendent of schools and the chief executive officer of the municipality in which the registrant resides, or plans to reside, of such release or new address, and to provide the same registry information for such registrant that the Department makes available to the public through the internet.
