

ICE/SNOW EARLY DISMISSAL

Any time school is dismissed during the school day because of inclement weather, all student activities including athletic practice sessions, athletic contests, are postponed. They may be rescheduled at a later date.

Should school be canceled prior to the beginning of class for the school day due to snow, ice or other inclement weather, athletic practice and contests, may be held with certain restrictions and conditions. It is understood that practice, contests, will not be conducted without the approval of the building level Principal in consultation with the Superintendent / District A.D. Should practice or an activity be permitted, it shall not occur prior to 1:00 p.m. The decision as to whether or not contests or performances will be held during the evening hours will be made by Principal in consultation with the Superintendent / District A.D. The decision shall be made by 1:00 p.m. in order to provide ample notice to parents.

ATHLETIC/ACTIVITY PRACTICES ON SNOW DAYS

1. First Snow Day - No Practices

After consultation with the Superintendent / District A.D., the Principal/A.D. may permit teams/groups to practice if conditions warrant, after 1:00 p.m. each day. Under most circumstances, it is recommended that no practice or activity occur on the day in which school is cancelled for inclement weather.

2. Second Snow Day and Others in a Series of Snow Days

After consultation with the District AD or Superintendent/Designee, the Principal/A.D. may permit teams/groups to practice if conditions warrant, after 1:00 p.m. each day. Under most circumstances, it is best practice to avoid practicing on the day school is cancelled for inclement weather.

3. Practices on all snow days must be voluntary on the part of team/group members. It is critical that parents are notified that the student will not be penalized for missing the practice.

4. Principal & Athletic Director are to check conditions at the school, either in person or by telephone with someone at the school, before a coach may contact athletes to schedule practice.

5. Before a contest/performance can take place on a snow day, approval must be given by the Principal and/or Athletic Director. If transportation is to be provided, approval from the Director of Transportation is required.
