

Thinking about hosting a FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENT?

Which Programs are Foreign Exchange Student accepted from?

How long can a Foreign Exchange Student attend school?

Foreign exchange students can attend for only one (1) school year for the purpose of gaining language and cultural experiences. Grade level placement of students shall be determined by the Principal.

What are the requirements for Foreign Exchange Student to enroll in school?

Foreign exchange students will be allowed to enroll only during the first five (5) school days of each semester.

The student must submit to the receiving school thirty (30) calendar days before enrollment a videotape of the student using conversational English to show the English speaking skills of the student.

The school will determine if the student's English speaking skills meet the enrollment requirements. These conditions and requirements may be modified in exceptional circumstances as determined by the Board upon recommendation of the Superintendent.

How is the Foreign Exchange Student's schedule determined?

The Principal and/or his/her designee will determine the student's schedule. Students will be expected to follow the school's rules of conduct and will follow the same disciplinary code as all students.

Foreign exchange students who are not in the U.S. on a visa issued specifically for educational purposes and thus have not paid the district yearly cost of educating a student may not be considered for graduation.
