

TRANSITION TIMELINE: *6th grade to Middle School*

Please note that this timeline is an optimistic plan used to guide district leadership through the transition. While the dates serve as a guide, flexibility will be necessary in some instances.

APPROXIMATE DATE(S)	TASK
August, 2014	The Warren County Board of Education (WCBOE) will vote whether or not to proceed with the move of 6 th grade to middle school. The transition will take place for the start of the 2017-2018 school year.
Fall, 2014	Following approval from the WCBOE, the “Local Planning / Facilities Committee” (LPC) meets to discuss construction options.
Fall, 2014	The LPC develops a proposal for construction.
Spring, 2015	Proposal reviewed and approved by WCBOE. Upon approval by Board, the proposal is sent to the State for approval and then returned back to WCBOE.
Spring, 2015	Following final approval from the WCBOE, architects will create proposals for new construction. Upon final Board and State approval on the plans, construction bids are submitted.
Summer, 2015	Once a bid is awarded, construction may start.
Winter, 2016- Spring, 2017	Staff decisions in regard to transition completed (collaborative effort between district leadership and school principals).
Summer, 2017	Construction completed.
August, 2017	6 th grade students should start the 2017-2018 school year in middle schools.
