Special Permission/Audition Classes

- Some classes have tryouts or auditions or applications
 - Please check with the coach/sponsor for specific audition requirements & dates for sports, fine arts, yearbook, and student council.
- Early Release/ Late Arrival
- Sports Medicine (must submit application)
- Teacher Aide, Office Aide, Library Aide (must submit application)
 - Only eligible for SENIORS
 - Must be on track to graduate and ahead on credits
 - Can only have one period of aide
- 9th grade: CTE Programs of Study in Welding, Auto Tech, Culinary, Cosmetology
 - Must attend FOCUS Night
 - Must submit application
- Dual Credit
 - Students taking dual credit for the first time, must attend FOCUS Night
 - Must submit application to Dallas College, complete TSI requirements (help will be provided)



Dual Credit Courses - Application Process

- What is Dual Credit?
 - College Classes, taught by College Professors through our partnership with Dallas College
- First-time Dual Credit students must attend mandatory student/parent meeting at FOCUS Night on January 19th at FHS.
- Students must take and pass the TSI (Texas Success Initiative) Exam to qualify.
 - Dates Available: Saturday, Jan 28th, Saturday, Feb 25th
 - Must Register in advance by published deadline
 - Email went out to all students previously (you already have this in your email inbox) with the link
- Students must apply to Dallas College at one of the application sessions hosted on the FHS campus in the upcoming month.
- When choosing classes, must choose both a S1 & an S2 class for each period.
- Current dual credit students interested in summer classes, need to register with their counselor at the same time you do your fall classes

Early Release / Late Arrival

- Eligible for 11th and 12th grade only
- 11th grade max of 2 periods of early release/late arrival
- 12th grade max of 3 periods if CCMR standard met
- Only 1 Late arrival (can be paired with early release)
- Must have transportation (cannot stay on campus)
- Must complete application in skyward
- Must be on track to graduate
- Talk to your counselors about specifics that affects this (transportation, job schedule, sports teams, specialty classes)



CCMR Criteria - Current Juniors you need this info!

Must have this to earn max number of Early Release/Late Arrival

Meet criteria of:

- → 3+ on any AP exam
- → Complete a dual credit course:
 - 9 hours or more in ANY subject
 - 3 hours or more in ELAR or Math
- → Meets TSI criteria or completed ELA/Math of Texas College Bridge
 - We are offering TSI in Jan and Feb on Saturdays! This is a way for you to earn this eligibility
- → Earn an Associate's degree
- → Industry Based Certification
- → SAT ELA Score 480, Math Score 530
- → ACT Composite Score of 23 with at least 19 on Eng, Math
- → Military Enlistment (signed contract)




Virtual Academy

- Application open for 2023-2024
- Deadline is March 1st!
- Students already enrolled in Virtual Academy do not need to reapply
- Only new virtual students should complete the application
- Application available in parent's Skyward account
- Student commitment is for the school year
- Some courses are not available in virtual setting. Work with your counselor to develop your plan for courses so you know what your options are.

What do I choose?

- All students choose classes to fill 8 periods. (Includes early release, late arrival, two or three period travel classes, athletics, band, etc.)
- Choose 2 alternates. There is a section for your courses and a separate tab for your alternates.
- If you are choosing dual credit classes, you must select both the S1 and S2 class for each period. (English 1301 for S1 and English 1302 for S2)
- Use your resources! Use the Guides!
- Future Ready Planning Guide & High School Course Guide
- Review your course selections with your parents! They need to be in the conversation, especially with all the new opportunities, schedules, and travel classes coming your way.



How to register for classes into Skyward - Step 1


<u>Step 1</u>:

- Log into Skyward
- Under the "Resources" drop down menu, click on "Skyward"
- Log in to Skyward using your student login information
- Click on "Schedule" (to the left of your home page)

How to register for classes into Skyward - Step 2



<u>Step 2:</u>

- Click on "Request Courses for 2023-24 in Forney HS" (top right of the page)
- Under "Available Courses" find the class you would like to take & click on it.
- Then click "Add Course" You will see the class you selected appear on the right under "Selected Courses"
- Add classes to equal 8 periods.



How to register for classes into Skyward - Step 3

Step 3: Add your 2 Alternate choices. To do this, click on "Request Alternate"

- Repeat the steps to add 2 alternates.
- When you are done, your requests are saved automatically. There is no "save" button. Just "log out".





Troubleshooting

- The course I need doesn't show up in the list!! What do I do?
 - Don't panic! Just let your counselor know and we can add the class manually.
- I don't know what alternates to sign up for.
 - Use the Future Ready Planning Guide and High School Course Guide links to access the courses offered and the detailed course descriptions. If you don't choose alternates, we will choose for you.
- I don't want to select alternates. I only want those 8 classes!
 - Sounds great in a perfect world. But there are always unresolvable conflicts. Always. If you don't have a back up plan ,we will make it for you.
- I have more questions! I need to talk to someone!
 - Remember, you will meet with your counselor to finalize your selections.



Choose carefully

- The master schedule is built on what you select now!
- We do not have every class every period. All schedules do not work and there are always unresolvable conflicts.
- Choose alternates you WANT to be in. Select viable alternate courses.
- Pay attention to classes that travel, are multiple periods, or have special applications including dual credit. We will not be flexible on deadlines for applications and dual credit because of the scheduling that has to be in place for these classes.
- Make sure you handle your business and get these extra items turned in or attend the meetings you need to (FOCUS night).
- Write down your questions for when you MEET with your counselor. We are coming to you - you do not need to schedule anything!

What's Next?

All course selections must be entered by students in Skyward by:

FRIDAY, JANUARY 27, 2023

After this, skyward will be closed for students.

Counselors will meet with students individually through classrooms February & March.
