All plan holders must have an active online account on [www.bidnetdirect.com](http://www.bidnetdirect.com) to acquire documents, receive project notifications, and to submit bids, electronically. **A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at Carr Park, located on Winslow Avenue in Medford, June 7, 2023, at 11:00 am, and June 8, 2023, at 11:00 am. Attendance at ONE pre-bid conference is mandatory for all prospective bidders, attendance at multiple pre-bid conferences is not required.**

Each Bid shall be submitted in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders and shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in form of a bid bond, or certified check, and/or a treasurer's or cashier's check issued by a responsible bank or trust company in the amount of five (5) percent of the bid. It is the responsibility of prospective proposers to check [www.BidNetDirect.com](http://www.BidNetDirect.com) for new information via any addenda to this solicitation. Any addenda issued will be emailed to all plan holders registered with BidNetDirect. Question deadline is **June 16, 2023, at 1:00 pm.**

It is the responsibility of the Bidder, before bid opening, to request, if necessary, any additional information on Minimum Wage Rates for those tradespeople who may be employed for the proposed work under this Contract.

The bidding and Award of this Contract will be under the provisions of M.G.L. c. 30, § 39M. The City of Medford reserves the right to accept any bid, in whole or in part, to reject any/or all bids and to waive minor irregularities and/or informalities as it deems to be in the best interest of the City.
