

Richland School District Two's athletic intra-district transfer procedures have changed. Below is a copy of the new procedures:

Intra-District Transfers

Rules and Procedures

1. Any student athlete who has an intra-district transfer with a bonafide change of residency shall maintain their athletic eligibility.
2. Any student athlete who has an intra-district transfer where they are leaving a choice school/program and returning to their zoned school shall be granted a one-time transfer (once in middle, once in high) without the loss of their athletic eligibility.
3. Any student athlete who has an intra-district transfer without a bonafide change of residency, or exceeded a one-time transfer to their home school, shall be athletically ineligible for one calendar year from the date of the transfer.
4. An appeal of eligibility may be made to the Richland Two Athletic Appeals Committee within five business days of ineligibility notification.
5. Parents with questions please contact the athletic director at your student's school.

Richland Two Athletic Appeals Committee

For Intra-district transfer eligibility

1. Appeals will be heard by a 7 member committee comprised of:
 1. Five high school principals
 2. One middle school principal
 3. Executive Director of Secondary Schools or designee
2. Appeals will be heard prior to each season during the week of the 15th of the following months:
 - May
 - July
 - October
 - February

3. The decision of the committee will be communicated in writing to parents/guardians of the student-athlete within five business days of the appeal hearing. The decision of the committee is final.
4. Eligibility appeals should be submitted in writing to the Executive Director of Secondary Schools. After receipt of the appeal, the parents/guardians of the student-athlete will be notified of the date of the hearing.
