PRESENTATIONS

A. Lakewood High School Innovation Center Project

Ms. Lisa Hawthorn, Lakewood High School Innovation Center Instructor, shared information on the “Lancer Little Libraries” project. A group of students are working with Hebron Elementary to design the blue prints for 4-5 little libraries that will be placed around the District. These little libraries are being funded by a grant that Hebron Elementary received. These designs will be judged by a panel in the next couple weeks. The Students will then make the little libraries and install them at selected locations throughout the District. Kabeb Fallure and Cole Scarborough also shared their little library designs.

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B. Teaching & Learning Update

Ms. Patti Pickering, Director of District Services, provided an update on the school improvement process. She shared information on what the school improvement process is; the District goals; the District Leadership Team and the Data Protocols. She reported that the District Leadership Team will be reviewing the Mid-Year Data from STAR and the High School will be reviewing their Quarterly Assessment Data starting next week. Once the District Leadership Team reviews they will communicate the data to the Building Level Teams for analysis of additional building data. She also provided the Board with a copy of the data for FY22.

Mr. Lohr asked how long the program has been incorporated at Lakewood. He also asked what is the biggest impact the last couple years. He asked if there was any collaboration with adults at home.

Mr. Lynch asked how many students are on target to make a year's worth of growth.

C. Lakewood Schools Update

Dr. Mark Gleichauf, Superintendent, provided the following updates:

- COVID-19 update
- State of the Schools – there were 50 who viewed live and to date there is over 1800 views
- A community survey will be open from February 14 – February 28, 2022. This is the first survey since 2018.
- Lancer Summer Institute 2022 – Administrators are beginning discussions on the upcoming Summer Institute.

Ms. Plaisted reported that the District was awarded \$135,000 toward the purchase of three (3) new school buses (\$45,000 per bus) through the School Bus Purchasing Program. The award period is November 1, 2021 – June 30, 2023. The Board of Education approved the purchase of two (2) buses at the December 2021 Regular Board meeting, with the effective purchase date of July 1, 2022. These two (2) buses will qualify to be used for the award. We are asking to approve one (1) more bus to be able to receive the full award allocation.
