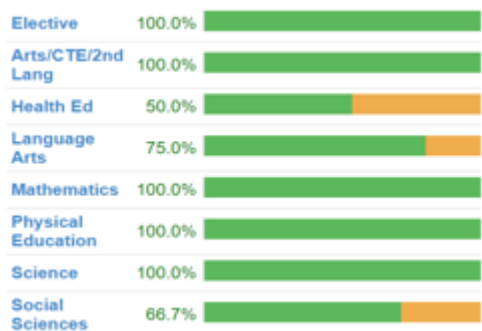

Senior Projects, College and Career 12 and Basic Computer skills are no longer graduation requirements.

Due to COVID-19 The State has waived the State testing requirement for Math, Writing and Reading.

If you are pursuing an Honors Diploma you must earn 9 credits or more while maintaining an unweighted GPA of 3.50 or higher. Students will have till the end of the year to earn credits towards their honors diploma.
