Dear School Community Members,

Our school system is committed to protecting student, teacher, and staff health. To protect our community and be compliant with the Department of Education regulations, the Watchung Borough School District tested our schools' drinking water for lead in November 2021.

In accordance with the Department of Education regulations, the district implemented immediate remedial measures for any drinking water outlet with a result greater than the action level of 15 μ g/l (parts per billion [ppb]). These measures include removing the outlets from use and providing alternate water sources.

Results of our Testing

Following instructions given in technical guidance developed by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, we identified and tested 54 drinking water and food preparation outlets. The testing results indicate that 51 designated drinking water and food preparation outlets were below the lead action level established by the US Environmental Protection Agency for lead in drinking water (15 μ g/l [ppb]).

The table below identifies the drinking water outlets that tested above the 15 μ g/l for lead, the actual lead level, and the remedial action taken. Please note that these fountains had not been in use since March 2020 and were taken out of service permanently.
