



Licking County Job and Family Services (LCJFS) has received additional funding due to the ongoing COVID-19 crisis. LCJFS continues to offer services to assist families with minor children. Services will be provided until funds are exhausted or a change in policy necessitates the modification or termination of services. Each category of assistance requires an application and has specific eligibility criteria, including the requirement that any support requested must be needed as a direct result of the COVID-19 crisis.

Below is a summary of available services:

For eligible families with minor children and an income at 200% or less of the federal poverty guideline:

- Assistance with utility costs
- Assistance with rent or mortgage and deposit
- Assistance with car payment or insurance
- Assistance with license plate or car registration fees
- Assistance with employment related transportation
- Assistance with employment related licensing fees
- Assistance with employment related work clothes or equipment
- Short-term training that promotes employment in a high-demand occupation
- One-time assistance payment (requires verification that applicant is required to quarantine due to suspected or confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis or exposure)
- One-time transition back to work payment to offset the incidental costs associated with returning to work during the economic recovery (requires verification of employment or re-employment)
