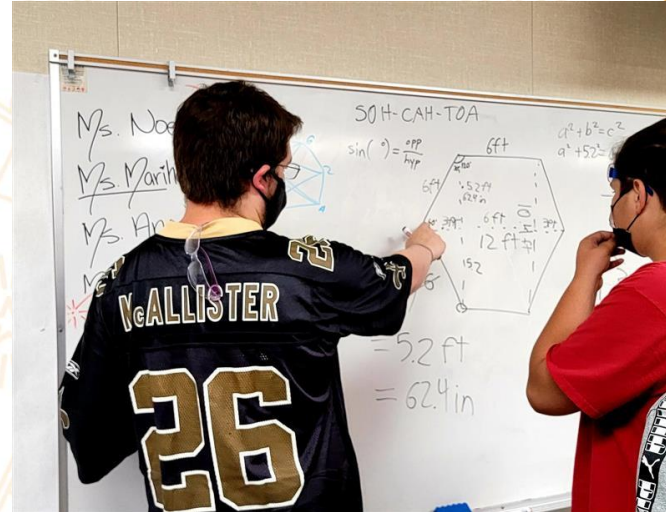
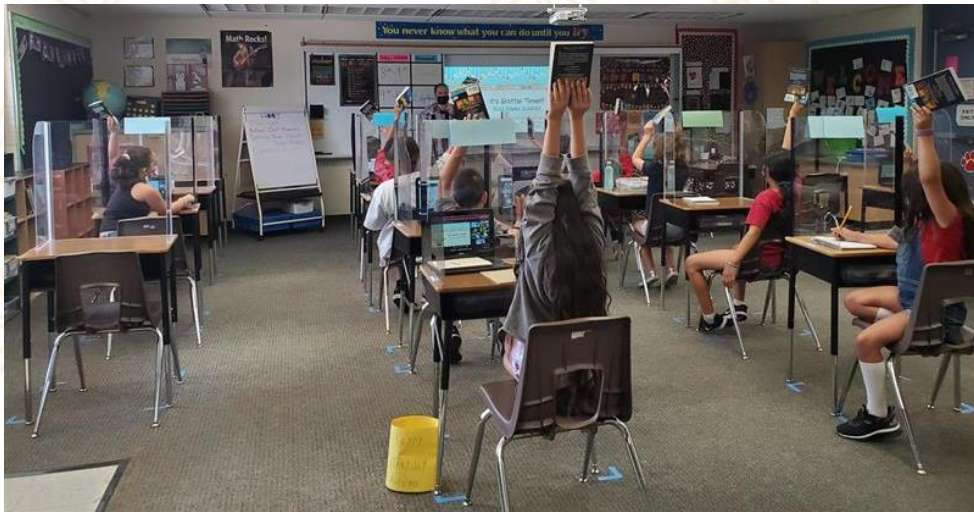
Program Offerings: Academics

Azusa USD's summer school reimagined provided students with an interactive and hands on experience, engaging students in deeper learning as they rotated through summer enhanced clubs and program offerings. AUSD Credential Teachers partnered with Think Together to develop project-based learning curriculum with a focus on English Language Arts including a **9th grade Summer Bridge** program. **Credit Recovery** offered to high school students included English, Math, PE, and APEX for 12-day sessions.

Program Offerings: STEM

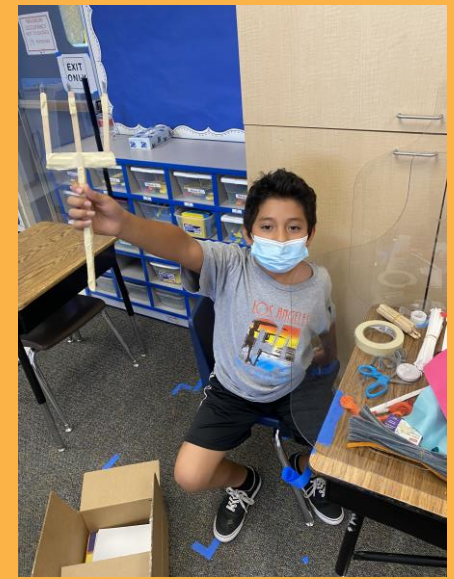
Invention Adventures Elementary/Middle



Students participate in creative, transdisciplinary problem-solving approach known as invention education. Helps students develop interest, confidence and capabilities in science, technology, engineering, and math utilizing everyday materials.

Drone Blocks High School

Utilizes Tello drones as a vehicle for teaching fundamental programming concepts. Students accomplish drone missions in block programming, Python, or NodeJS.



Program Offerings: Physical Activity

Fitness & Sports Stacking Elementary/Middle

Introducing sport stacking as a competitive element that can be done safely. Staff guide students by developing proficiency and self-confidence.



Fulcrum Elementary/Middle

Offers fun and enriching experiences for youth outside of the traditional classroom context. Programs actively engage students to lead, solve problems, make decisions individually and as part of a team.



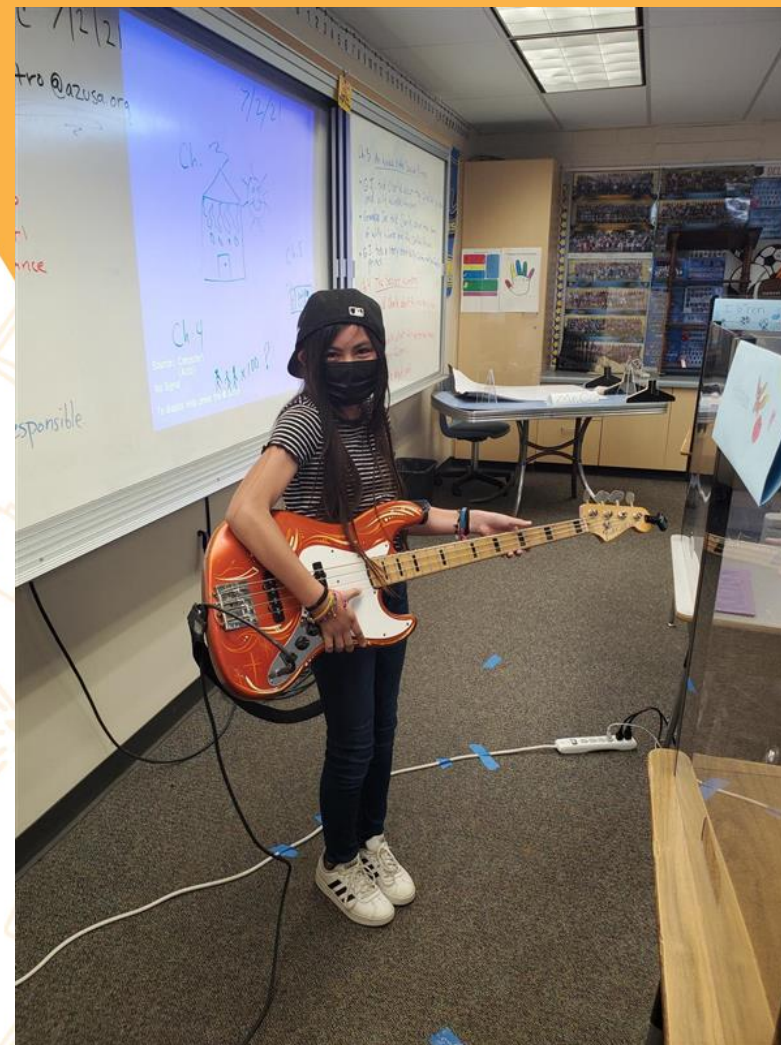
Program Offerings: Visual & Performance Arts

Move & Groove Elementary

Focuses on getting children to groove in their own way. They can dance their wiggles out by following an instructional video of someone teaching them how to dance. Every day explores a different groove theme song.

Teach Rock Middle/High School

Teach rock is a reading intervention program that provides comprehensive, explicit, and systematic instruction in the five essential components of reading and includes language and writing. Students learn about the history of music, past events, and artists!



High School

WREP – Workforce Readiness Education Program

Comprehensive program to prepare high school students for the professional workplace through training, hands-on practice, and career-oriented work experience.

Driver's Ed

In partnership with State Farm's Drive Safe program, teen driver education completed online to prepare teens for the California driver permit test.

Project Citizen

Introduces students to government and civics. Students identify, research, and solve a public program. Program culminates with the development of students presenting a public policy proposal.

Dude. Be Nice

Program creates a more conscious culture. Staff support young people to build a positive community by building communities that support kindness and compassion. Culminates with a student led community project.
