COMMUNITY SERVICE

For activities to qualify as community service they should:

- Be for the benefit of an individual or group
- Provide service in an area of need
 - Be unpaid

Example:

· Volunteering at a bake sale

- Picking up trash around a community building
 - Helping at an animal shelter

Requirement:

20 hours by graduation for 2019 and 2020 students

How to get credit for hours:

- Fill out the Service to Community form
 - · Have supervisor sign off on it
 - Turn it into Mrs. McQuerry

A+ Hours

For activities to qualify as A+ hours they should:
Be tutoring/mentoring an individual or small group

Teaching others academics or skills
Be unpaid

Example:

Helping a 4th grader with flash cards
Mentoring at Adventure Club
Coaching younger students at an athletic or music camp

Requirement:

50 hours by April of senior year for students enrolled in A+

How to get credit for hours:

Fill out the A+ Tutoring Log
Have teacher/supervisor sign off on it
Turn it into Mrs. McQuerry
