

COMMUNITY SERVICE

For activities to qualify as community service they should:

- Be for the benefit of an individual or group
- Provide service in an area of need
- Be unpaid

Example:

- Volunteering at a bake sale
- Picking up trash around a community building
- Helping at an animal shelter

Requirement:

20 hours by graduation for 2019 and 2020 students

How to get credit for hours:

- Fill out the Service to Community form
- Have supervisor sign off on it
- Turn it into Mrs. McQuerry

VS

A+ HOURS

For activities to qualify as A+ hours they should:

- Be tutoring/mentoring an individual or small group
- Teaching others academics or skills
- Be unpaid

Example:

- Helping a 4th grader with flash cards
- Mentoring at Adventure Club
- Coaching younger students at an athletic or music camp

Requirement:

50 hours by April of senior year for students enrolled in A+

How to get credit for hours:

- Fill out the A+ Tutoring Log
- Have teacher/supervisor sign off on it
- Turn it into Mrs. McQuerry
