

Public Notice of Intent to Apply for Federal Grant Funds

Kilgore Independent School District will apply for Federal Grant Funds for the 2022-2023 school year. Kilgore ISD plans to use these funds to support the intent and purposes of said grants.

Intent to apply for ESSA Consolidated Grant should include:

Title Program	Intent and Purpose	Expected Entitlement	Summary of planned expenditures
Title I, A	Improving Basic Programs	\$980,000	Provides supplemental funding to improve the quality of education programs and ensure students from low-income families have opportunities to meet challenging state assessments.
Title II, A	Supporting Effective Instruction	\$160,000	To support educators in their work to improve the overall quality of instruction and ensure equity of educational opportunity for all students.
Title III, ELA	English Language Acquisition, Language Enhancement, and Academic Achievement Act	\$75,000	To ensure that English Learners (ELs) and immigrant students attain English proficiency and develop high levels of academic achievement in English.
Title IV	Student Support and Academic Enrichment	\$60,000	To increase the capacity of state education agencies, local educational agencies (LEAs), campuses, and communities to meet the following three goals: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provide all students access to a well-rounded education 2. Improve academic outcomes by maintaining safe and healthy students 3. Improve the use of technology to advance student academic achievement
IDEA-B	Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), Part B	\$700,000	Provides federal funding for the education of children with disabilities and requires, as a condition for the receipt of such funds, the provision of a free appropriate public education (FAPE) for children with disabilities.
Carl Perkins Grant (Perkins V)	The Strengthening Career and Technical Education (CTE) for the 21 st Century	\$40,000	Ensures all students can benefit from high-quality CTE programs that prepare them for high-skill, high-wage employment.
