
Measure 📴 – Just the Facts

Visalia Unified School District – School Construction Bond Ballot Measure – November 6, 2012

Passage of Measure is <u>not</u> projected to increase the property tax rate, but would provide local dollars to maintain Visalia Unified facilities at the level our students and community deserve and have come to expect.

Purpose of the Bond

- Improve the quality of education
- Prevent overcrowding
- Repair aging school facilities
- Improve access for students with disabilities



New Construction

- Middle school construction (Riggin & Akers)
- Multi-purpose cafeteria rooms
- Additional classrooms

Fiscal Accountability

- All bond funds used for school construction and repairs
- No funds for salaries and benefits
- Independent Citizen's Oversight Committee to monitor and report on all bond expenditures

Financial Facts about Measure



- No projected increase in the tax rate
- Only an *Extension* of the current bond tax rate of \$30 per \$100,000 of assessed property value
- \$60.1 million Bond
- Estimated \$120 million in school facility projects with State matching funds
- Funds cannot be taken by the State

Intended Improvements and Repairs

Every school over 10 years old will benefit from

Measure **5**. Examples of projects include:

- Renovation of restrooms for improved access
- Replace leaking roofs
- Playground safety improvements
- Repair and replace portable buildings
- Improve energy efficiency and technology
- Update fire alarms and security systems
- Interior and exterior classroom painting
