An Excellent Education



- Property tax passed in 1999
- Costs a homeowner \$30 per year per \$100,000 valuation Example: Assessed Value = \$143,050, annual cost = \$42.90
- Generated \$49 million
- Made possible \$120 million in projects







Repair or replace:


- Leaking roofs

With an emphasis on energy savings












- Over 4,000 students in middle school
- 800 more coming based upon current elementary enrollment and birth rates
- It takes 4 years to build a middle school
- And approximately \$35 million









- Measure E would generate \$60 million
- And allow VUSD to leverage state matching funds
- Total over \$120 million to invest in local schools
