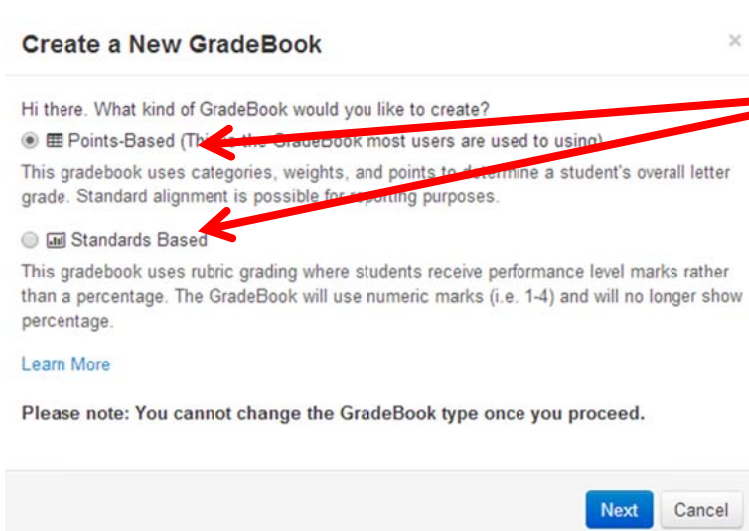
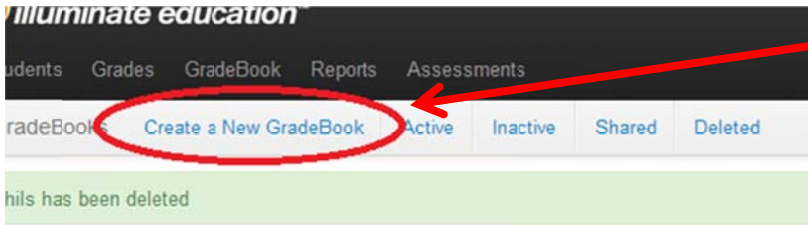


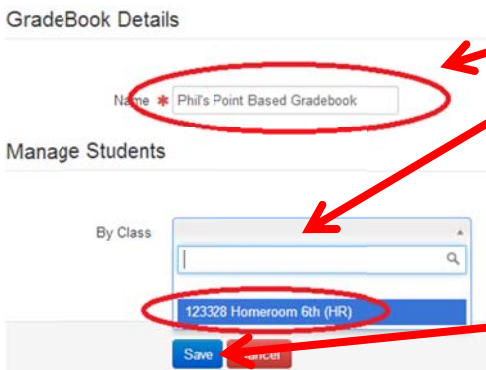
GRADE BOOKS

To create a new grade book, click on the “Create a New GradeBook” link located near the navigation bar:

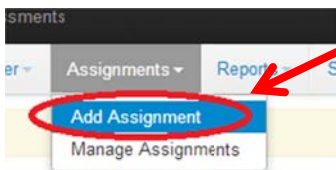


You will need to decide if this gradebook will be “Points-based” or “Standards based.” If you choose “points-based,” you will be able to link individual assignments to the report card in the location you decide. If you select “standards-based” then you select the standard for the assignment, and the report card will be populated based on the standard you selected.

If selecting the “**Points-Based**” option, you will be required to name the gradebook, and assign it to a class:



After clicking the “Save” button, you can begin adding assignments by using the “Add Assignment” option located under the “Assignments” tab in the navigation bar:

Selecting the “Standards-Based” option allows a standard to be linked to the assignment, but does not necessarily link that standard to the report card. If the desire is to link a “Standards-Based” gradebook to the report card, go to the report card, and link that grade book, next to the location where you can link assessments:
