

FINDING WHICH SCORES CONTRIBUTE TO A REPORT CARD VALUE

The Score Breakdown link lists which sources contribute to the value in a report card if a teacher linked assessments or gradebooks. To get to the Score Breakdown link, go to the “Entry” option under the “Grades” tab:

Click the “Find Students” button as you normally would:

Select the appropriate report card to work on, and click the “Load” button:

Select the report card area in question, and click on the link:

In the leftmost column, to the right of the printing icon, there is a link that generates the “Score Breakdown” for each student for this particular report card section:

The columns list the standards that are pertinent for that report card section, along with the standards that are linked to that section of the report card. At the very bottom of the list, below all the standards, are the sources of assessments and/or gradebooks that contribute to the score.

In some cases, both assessment and gradebook entries contribute to the score. The user will need to be aware as to which is an assessment, and which is a gradebook. For instance, Grade 05 Wonders Unit 1 Week 4 is probably a test, and Epp/First Trimester – Weighted Overall Score is probably a gradebook link in this other example:
