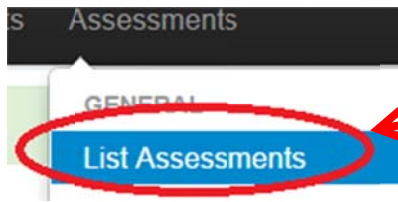


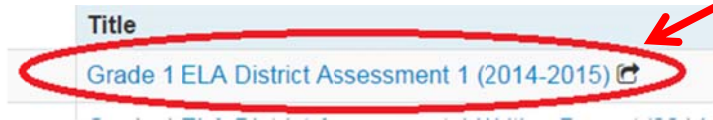
# MODE AND DIMENSION VALUES FOR PAPER & PENCIL REPORT CARDS

The entry for Mode and Dimensions will be automatically populated for those individuals using the Illuminate electronic report card, and the information is a result of student performance on selected items from the district ELA assessment. The same information can be obtained from the “Custom Report” associated with the district assessment.

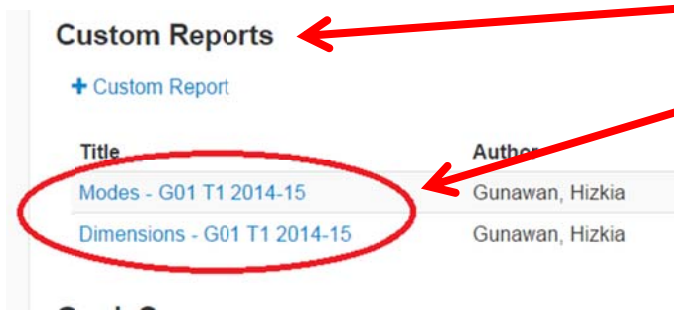
1. To view the entries, find the district assessment under the “Assessment” tab by listing assessments:



2. Filter to the appropriate, current, district ELA assessment:



3. And click on the title to go to the overview screen for that test, and scroll down to the Custom Report” section:



4. If beginning with the “Modes” entries, click on the “Modes” link. Only entries for English Learners are required, and these may be found in the right-most column (these values are modified for this PDF):
