PH620: Principles of Public Health Methods

Credit: 3 hours

Course Overview: This course is focused on the core scientific disciplines - biostatistics and epidemiology - used to produce evidence for public health policies and programs. At the completion of this course, students will be able to recommend an appropriate study design for a given research question and articulate the generalizability of the results.
