### **Mrs. Steger shared the annual report for parents.**

- Teachers have received \$16,026 in Donors Choose
  - books for classroom libraries
  - novel studies
  - classroom rewards
- We have seen a lot of growth in our staff (off campus PD, conferences around the U.S., etc.)
- River Rock Church partnership this year
- On the second page of the report, it shows school events, and completed course work
- The STAR testing results show that our students are continuing to meet their SGP (more than a year's worth of growth)
- We will continue to work in PLCs and have set aside time for collaboration
- STAR reports will begin coming home soon
- SC Ready testing is soon, scores are released in the Summer
- We focused on Math in PLCs the first year and saw significant growth. This year, we added ELA. It's much more subjective, so it's taking time, but we are doing well and are excited to see scores.
- We will continue working on Essential Standards and some vertical alignment, choosing standards that will continue in future grade levels (reading a graph, retelling a story, etc.)
