To qualify for C.S.F. membership this semester you must follow these guidelines:

1. You must earn a **MINIMUM** of 10 points based on last semester's grades
 - a. At least **4 points** must be from List 1 (unless you are a senior applying for Feb. or June membership).
 - b. The first **7 points** (including the 4 listed above) must be from Lists I and II. (Senior pts may all come from List II)
 - c. The **remaining points** may come from any list.
2. You may use **NO MORE THAN 5 classes** to qualify and a minimum of **4 classes**.
3. No C.S.F. points are given for P.E., courses taken in lieu of P.E. (i.e. Weight Training), courses **repeated** for an improved grade, teacher/office aide courses, and/or courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
4. C.S.F. points are granted as follows:
 - a. a grade of "A" = 3 C.S.F. points
 - b. a grade of "B" = 1 C.S.F. point
 - c. a grade of "C" = 0 points
 - d. **A grade of "D" or "F" in ANY course** (even courses you cannot use to qualify) **disqualifies you** from membership this semester.

ONE ADDITIONAL point is granted for an A or B in an honors, AP or IB course, with a **maximum of 2 extra points** per application.

Currently, CSF does **not** grant additional points for four-year university level, four-year university transferable community college level coursework or Dual Enrollment (DE).

REMEMBER:

Points may **NOT** be assigned for **REPEATED COURSES**

- Semester membership is based on work done in the *previous semester*. **Summer courses may NOT be used for C.S.F. membership.**
- You **must** reapply each semester.
- Sealbearers must have a minimum of **4 semesters of membership, starting from their 2nd semester of their sophomore through their 2nd semester of their senior years**
 - One of these semesters **must** be based on senior year grades.
- Courses that may be used for membership are listed on the back and are divided into List I, List II and List III courses.
