Regulations:

1. To provide a safe and positive environment at school events, Mt. Whitney High reserves the right to deny admission to anyone regardless of approval from their home school.
2. Guest passes may be picked up in the Counseling Office or from Activities Secretary and must be approved by a MWHS High School Administrator at least 2 days prior to the event.
3. A guest must be **under the age of 21 and at least a 9th grader** at the time of the event.
4. If a high school student, the guest must be in good standing at the school of their attendance.
5. An alternative education student must be in good standing at the school of their attendance, and did not commit an expellable offense leading to their placement at the alternative school site; is a student in good standing in the alternative education program for a minimum of three weeks.
6. If under the age of 18, students who have dropped out of school will not be granted a Guest Pass.
7. A student or guest who leaves the event may not return.
8. Any violations of the VUSD student conduct code during the event will result in parent notification, possible removal from the event and appropriate discipline procedures upon return to school.
9. If a student transfers from Mt. Whitney High School but is still on the current academic in-eligibility list at Mt. Whitney High School, they will not be permitted to attend.
10. Inappropriate or suggestive dancing is not allowed and may result in removal from a dance.
11. Students are limited to one guest per event.
