A normal course load for a semester is five academic courses and one elective.

Dual Enrollment: Juniors are eligible to enroll in one of the approved dual enrollment courses at the College of Coastal Georgia each semester. Seniors are eligible to enroll in two of the approved dual enrollment courses at the College of Coastal Georgia each semester.

Online Courses: Online elective courses may be taken through Fuel Education, Georgia Virtual School, or John Hopkins CTY at the student's expense. Online courses may not take the place of required courses offered on campus. Applications must be approved by the Upper School Administration.
