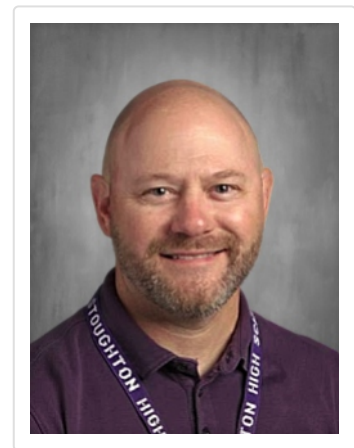

A Message from Mr. Kruse, Principal

Students and Families,

Stoughton High School Graduation is this **Sunday, June 4 at 11:00 am**. Congratulations to the Class of 2023!

Seniors: Please get set up in your graduation homerooms at 10:15 am. Enter through door #1. Door #1 will be open to come into the building at 10:00 am. Graduation homerooms will be posted at door #1. Immediately following the ceremony, you will pick up your diploma in the PAC lobby.



Graduation Attendees: Golf cart ushering from the parking lots to the field is available for those with decreased mobility. One cart will be departing from door #2 and one will be departing from the back lot. There is accessible seating at the field. Graduation 2023 is not a ticketed event and seats are not available for reservation. Graduation will only be livestreamed if we are in our inclement weather location (SHS Main Gym). If outside, local cable channel WSTO will be recording graduation to be played at a later date.

The final determined location of graduation will be posted on the main page of the SASD website by 9:00 am Sunday morning.

Transcript Requests

Just a reminder that if you are a senior who is planning to attend college this fall, you must send your final transcript showing proof of graduation to your college. You can do this through Parchment (www.parchment.com).

Final transcripts will not be ready until mid June, but you can put your request in now. Counselors will hold on processing any senior transcripts until final grades are posted. Below are step by step instructions.

Child Work Permits Moving to Online Only, In-Person Ends June 30

The online application is live now. A parent can access the site [using these instructions](#). Payment is made directly to the department through the application, using a credit or debit

card or by ACH direct withdrawal. Once the permit application process is complete, the Department mails a paper copy of the permit directly to the employer.

The old system will continue to be operational until June 30, 2023, when it will be discontinued. The offices of schools in Stoughton will no longer be issuing work permits.
