

HELP US KEEP OUR KIDS HEALTHY! GUIDELINES FOR SENDING AND KEEPING KIDS HOME:

- 1. fever of 100 degrees or higher
- 2. vomiting
- 3. diarrhea
- 4. undiagnosed/suspicious rash or head lice

If your child is home with a fever, he or she needs to be fever free for 24 hours without the help of fever reI ducing medicines before returning to school.

If your child is placed on an antibiotic, they need 24 hours of the medicine before returning to school


