Clinic News

If your child will be taking medication during the 2022-2023 school year, please have any forms completed and returned to your child's school BEFORE the first day of the school year. The forms are available in the school clinic.



Please remember that all prescription medications must be in a pharmacy labeled bottle and match the doctor's order.

If the child is taking over the counter medication, it must be in the original packaging, only one dose sent to school at a time and needs to match the OTC form that is signed by a parent.

Please call your child's school nurse if you have any questions, or need to request that your meds go home with your student.

Every day counts. Missing school even 10% of the time has a significant negative impact on academic achievement as children progress through school. Students with good attendance perform better academically. Good attendance starts early. Research has shown that the attendance habits established early have lasting effects on students throughout their education. Your child needs to be in school and engaged in learning to reach his or her full potential.

We realize that every family faces challenges. Please let your child's principal know if you are dealing with a challenge affecting your child's good school attendance. Your school family will help you ensure that your child's school attendance stays on track.

BIRTHDAY CELEBRATIONS

Due to the increased number of food allergies we can no longer accept birthday treats to share with

the class. Instead, we highly recommend alternative celebration items such as a birthday pencil or donating a book to the classroom library in your child's name.



SafeArrival used for absence reporting and notifications

All WCSD families will report student absences through a secure system called **SafeAr-rival**. In addition to reducing the time it takes to verify student attendance, this system gives families more options to report a child's absence and allows our staff to immediately investigate discrepancies. This is especially important when a child is reported absent during attendance and the office has not been notified that the student would be missing school that day. SafeArrival is part of the district's SchoolMessenger notification system.



Beginning in August, families will be able to report and/or schedule absences through any of the following options: an app on their mobile device, a secure website, or a dedicated toll-free telephone number (1-844-431-0874).

Please download the <u>SafeArrival FAQ</u> and also visit <u>https://go.schoolmessenger.com</u> to learn more. Be sure to <u>create an account</u> for the SchoolMessenger website and also download the free app for <u>Apple</u> devices or Android devices.

If a parent/guardian forgets to report their student's absence, they will begin to receive automated notifications once the child is marked absent at school. The notification process ends when the parent/guardian confirms the absence through SafeArrival. Safeguards, such as establishing a PIN number, are in place to prevent students from reporting their own absence.

SafeArrival is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Future absences, such as known medical appointments, can be scheduled at any time. The app is convenient, the toll-free number is districtwide, and the dedicated website also provides access to an archive of messages sent to families through the district's notification system.

News from the cafeteria:

Westerville City Schools families can apply online to have their child/children receive free or reduced-price school meals

For nearly two years, the United States Department of Agriculture issued waivers that have provided no-cost school meals to all students across the nation. But those waivers expired at the end of the 2021-22 school year. That means WCSD families will have to resume paying for breakfast and lunch school meals when students return to class after summer break



School meal prices for the 2022-23 school year include:

- Breakfast \$1.25 elementary; \$1.50 middle and high school
- Lunch \$2.75 elementary; \$3 middle and high school
- Reduced-price meals for those who qualify 40 cents for lunch. (Breakfast is free for students who qualify for reduced-price meals.)

Student breakfast and lunch prices remain the same as they have been dating back to the 2017-18 school year.

Families who wish to apply for free or reduced-price meals must complete the application for meal benefits on the Lunch Application <u>website</u>. Paper applications are also available at school buildings, the Enrollment Center, and at the district Food Service office located at 936 Eastwind Drive. Families are encouraged to fill out online applications as they are a more efficient method of applying for free or reduced priced meals. On average, online applications are processed within 24 to 48 hours of completion.

For your convenience, parents are able to pay by cash or check with money taken to the school cafeteria. Online payments can be made at no additional cost to parents.
