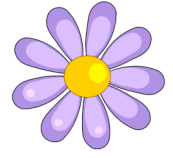

2019-2020 FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL ANNOUNCED....

For those of you already planning for summer camps and summer vacations, the first day of school for the 2019-2020 year has been announced as Tuesday, August 13th, 2019.



ATTENDANCE LAW

Ohio (HB 410) wants to help students that miss a lot of school.

THE LAW SAYS: It's important that each child is at school every day unless they are SICK. It is important to contact the school as soon as you are aware that your child is going to be absent!

UNEXCUSED ABSENCES: If your child has 30 hours or more of unexcused consecutive absences in a month, 42 hours or more of absences (but not consecutive) in a month, and/or 72 more hours of unexcused absences in a School year your child is considered to be "habitually truant". In the case of "habitually truant" situations the law requires that a meeting is held at the school with the principal, parent, teacher and other support staff to come up with a plan to improve attendance. We know there can be challenges and special situations — Mark Twain is here to help!

Per the new law schools now define absence in terms of hours. Excused Absences: If your child has 38 hours or more of excused absence in a month (not necessarily in a row) and/or 65 or more hours of excused absences in a school year your child is considered to be "excessively absent". By law the school office must send written notice home to the family notifying them of excessive absences. Letters will be sent after the 5th and the 10th day. (Please remember this applies to both excused or unexcused absences).

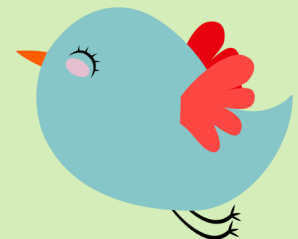

- Walnut Springs Middle School, 888 E. Walnut Street, April 25 at 6:00 p.m.



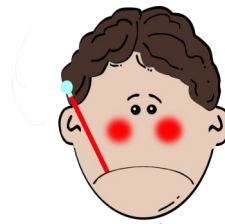

A NOTE FROM THE CLINIC

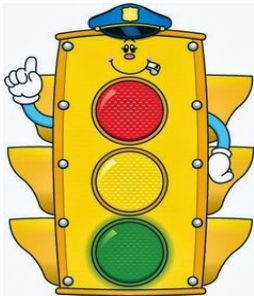
HANDWASHING: With today's hi-tech approach to healthcare, it's easy to forget the simplest way to avoid infection—handwashing. With a little soap and water you can often prevent what may take lots of time and money to cure. What's proper handwashing? Thorough handwashing isn't simple. Here are some quick tips:

- Use soap and warm running water
- Scrub your hands together for at least 20 seconds/two times through the Happy Birthday song
- Wash: backs of hands, wrists, between fingers, and under fingernails
- Rinse well
- Dry hands with a paper towel
- Turn off the water using a paper towel instead of bare hands



When should you wash? It's virtually impossible to keep your hands germfree, but there are times when it's critical to wash your hands. Always wash:

- After you visit the bathroom
- After handling garbage
- After playing with a pet
- Before you handle or eat food
- After changing a diaper
- After handling money
- After blowing your nose, sneezing or coughing in your hand
- After handling uncooked food (especially meat)



Westerville Safety City

Westerville Safety City is a program designed to teach students entering kindergarten in the fall about a variety of safety issues. Each student is taught basic rules of traffic and pedestrian safety, fire prevention, school bus safety, poison prevention, animal safety, gun safety, water safety, and stranger awareness. The program is operated by a non-profit organization. This organization coordinates the cooperative efforts of a variety of Westerville entities including the Westerville Divisions of Fire, Police and Communications. The Westerville City School participate by allowing the use of their facilities for the program.
