HANDWASHING: With today's hi-tech approach to healthcare, it's easy to forget the simplest way to avoid infection—handwashing. With a little soap and water you can often prevent what may take lots of time and money to cure. What's proper handwashing? Thorough handwashing isn't simple. Here are some guick tips:

- Scrub your hands together for at least 20 seconds/two times through the Happy Birthday song
- Uwash: backs of hands, wrists, between fingers, and under fingernails
- Rinse well
- Dry hands with a paper towel
- Turn off the water using a paper towel instead of bare hands

When should you wash? It's virtually impossible to keep your hands germfree, but there are times when it's critical to wash your hands. Always wash:

- After you visit the bathroom
- After handling garbage
- After playing with a pet
- Defore you handle or eat food
- After changing a diaper
- After handling money
- After blowing your nose, sneezing or coughing in your hand
- After handling uncooked food (especially meat)

Walnut Springs Middle School, 888 E. Walnut Street, May 10 @ 6:30 p.m.



For those of you already planning for summer camps and summer vacations, the first day of school for the 2017-2018 year has been announced as Thursday, August 17, 2017.




VOLUNTEER LUNCHEON ..Thanks for CHIPPIN' IN!
