The Lighthouse Special Needs Ministry at Connection Pointe ensures that the needs of every child are addressed through intentional assessment and planning. We want your child to have the best hour of their whole week here at church learning about Jesus.

Buddy Program: (available at all weekend services) An adult or teen will be designated to each student or child with special needs who may need an additional level of familiar comfort or support during large group teaching and small group time.

Lighthouse Small Group: This is a sensory friendly small group that meets during the 11:15am Sunday service in Kid City. Each volunteer has experience working with children with special needs. The volunteer to child ratio is typically 1:2. The team adapts the curriculum and provides flexible large group teaching experiences guided by each child who attends the small group.

Sensory Room: If your child is ever feeling overwhelmed in Kid City, a sensory room is available to help them calm and get regulated before returning to their small group.

Parents Night Out: These are occasional respite childcare nights for children with special needs and their siblings. Every child in attendance will have an adult or teen buddy. Children and staff are provided food and engage in crafts and games while parents get a few hours to relax.

All Lighthouse volunteers have a current background check on file.
