



**UNM Medical Group School-based Health Centers (SBHCs) are open!!!**

**What you should know for 2022-2023**

- We have six clinic sites across Albuquerque.
- ALL APS students and APS charter students are eligible for our services. We offer appointments before, during, and after school hours.
- Our clinics are open for on-site care-- and --we can also do appointments by video calls, if preferred.
- We provide:
  - **Behavioral health** services including emotional wellness screening, counseling, therapy, substance use counseling and referrals when needed
  - **Medical care** including wellness exams, sports physicals, reproductive and sexual health services, injury and illness care, and vaccines.
    - We provide all routine child and adolescent immunizations except varicella (as that requires freezing). These are provided at our MS and HS sites (see below).
    - We do not carry flu or COVID vaccines.
  - **Case Management** for students receiving our care who need this.
  - **Psychiatry services** for students receiving our care who need this. Students just need to have an appointment with one of our medical providers or behavioral therapists to establish with us.
- We do not provide:
  - COVID care, including testing, treatment, or covid immunization
  - Varicella vaccine (but have all other routine child and adolescent immunizations).
- Teens can call to make appointments for themselves for confidential sexual and reproductive health services and behavioral health services.
