In Term 6, our theme will be, 'The Seaside'.

CURRICULUM COVERAGE

English

It's time to set sail across the 7 seas as we embark on our very last English units of the year. The children will be using Jonny Duddle's bestselling Pirate series to inspire their fiction writing. Duddle is a complete master when it comes to characterisation and his writing style, illustrations and the 'Jolley-Rogers' are sure to capture their imaginations. Using imagery from Flotsam by David Wiesner, the children will again have opportunities to put their creative writing skills to show and develop their story writing skills. Flotsam is a great talking point for non-fiction writing, the children will learn more about what inhabits the world's oceans and problems it is facing as they practise writing to inform.

Maths

In Maths, we will start the term by focussing on Position and Direction. We will begin by looking at lots of positional language and using this to describe where things are before moving on to using this language to describe movements and turns. We will then be putting this learning into practice within our work in Geography. Later in the term we will move on to Measurement where we will be completing lots of practical activities to do with mass and capacity as well as practicing reading a variety of different scales. To finish the term we will spend some time looking at Statistics and how we can present data in different ways, including pictograms and block graphs.

Geography

In Geography, we will be studying Hastings seafront and how it has change over time. We will be developing our geographical skills through fieldwork, inquiry and map-based activities throughout the lessons.

History

In History, will be learning about Hastings seaside, how it has changed over time and compare it to other seaside resorts.
