



Term 6

Where for Art Thou?

5th June – 20th July





Over the next term our theme will be Shakespeare, specialising in his famous play, Romeo and Juliet.

<u>Curriculum Coverage</u>

English & Destination Reader

We will be focusing on Shakespeare's classic Romeo and Juliet, writing modern narratives to the story. We will also be exploring formal and informal letter writing and looking at playscripts (very appropriate for our end of term musical!).

Maths

Over the coming term we will be taking part in lots of different mathematical investigations, real life problem solving and beginning to look at Year 7 level maths activities. We also look forward to our exciting Maths Day on 16th June (more info to come!).

History

We will be doing a small study on Native Americans, specifically focusing on the local conversationalist, Grey Owl.

DT

We will be making felt phone cases. This project will teach your class about how to write their own design criteria. They will design products with the user in mind thinking about aesthetics and functionality. Children will learn how to make a paper template and how to sew a running stitch, backstitch, whip stitch and blanket stitch. Finally, when they have made their felt phone case, children will learn how to write a detailed evaluation.

Computing

Big Data unit –

This unit will look at understanding how corruption can happen within data during transfer (for example when downloading, installing, copying and updating files), that computer networks provide multiple services. Also using search and word processing skills to create a presentation. Finally we will have a go at creating formulas and sorting data within spreadsheets.

PE

In PE this term we will be focusing on Outdoor Education. The unit focuses on problem-solving activities and challenges. Throughout the unit, children will be required to work as part of a team to solve a range of different problems that focus on collaboration and effective communication, testing their levels of perseverance, as well as leadership skills – this unit will get us ready for PGL!

RE

In RE we will be covering the unit 'What do Christians believe Jesus did to 'save' people?' We will be outlining the 'big story' of the Bible, explaining how Incarnation and Salvation fit

within it. We will also be looking at what Christians mean when they say that Jesus' death was a sacrifice Understand the impact: We will be making clear connections between the Christian belief in Jesus' death as a sacrifice and how Christians celebrate Holy Communion/Lord's Supper.

Music

Our focus this term will be on the genre of Funk, Soul & Country. Listening, sharing and evaluating that genre of music and focusing on – Brad Paisley/Stevie Wonder as a case study. We will also be taking part in performing musical songs during rehearsals and performances of our end of year musical 'The Greatest Show'.
