COMMENCEMENT TICKETS

Four (4) complimentary general admission tickets have been reserved for each senior. Seating is first come, first served. **Ten (10)**, additional tickets may be purchased for \$10 each on the UHS Online Student Store starting Wednesday May 31st at 7AM until June 5th at 9AM or until all tickets sell out. Tickets will only be available ONLINE during this selling period. There will be NO refunds. **Parking at the Arena is \$10 per car.** The Toyota Arena is a CASHLESS Venue. LOST OR STOLEN TICKETS WILL NOT BE REPLACED.

GRADUATION TICKET DISTRIBUTION

The **Four (4)** complimentary general admission tickets and the purchased six tickets can be picked up from the **Student Store before school and After School until June 8th at 2PM.** The additional 10 tickets that go on sale **Wednesday May 31st will be distributed on Wednesday June 7th** before school (8AM) and after school (until 3PM) on the Northside of the Administration building. After this date all tickets will be able to be picked up from the student store before and after school until June 8th. No tickets will be distributed during lunch.

In order to pick up your tickets your HOLDS must be cleared:

- Student Services - No Saturday Schools or Detentions
- FAFSA or FAFSA waiver must be completed
- Counseling - Senior Exit Survey must be completed
- Student Store - All fees must be paid. Fees can be viewed in the online student store portal.
- Library - Clear library fines. Books checked out for this school year do not need to be turned in before ticket pick-up. [Click Here](#) to access information about Library fines.

If you have not cleared your holds you can pick up tickets on June 8th from the Student Store.

OUTSTANDING SCHOOL PROPERTY AND DISCIPLINE

UUSD Board Policy dictates that any senior who has damaged or unreturned school property (i.e. library books or athletic uniforms) may not be permitted to participate in Commencement. Tickets may not be distributed to students who have outstanding charges, detentions, or Saturday Schools. Diplomas and transcripts may not be issued to students with outstanding charges.

SENIOR AWARDS PROGRAM

The Senior Awards Program will be held in the Highlander Auditorium at 6:00pm **Thursday, June 1**. Many outstanding seniors will be honored for their accomplishments. Seniors received an email invitation to the Awards on May 19th if they were receiving an Award at this event.

SENIOR COMMENCEMENT ASSEMBLY

Attendance at the Senior Commencement Assembly is **REQUIRED** of all seniors who intend to participate in the Commencement Ceremony. There will be no rehearsal scheduled at the Arena. All seniors must report for the **Senior Commencement Assembly at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday June 8 (please note that this time is different from the Graduation Agreement)** in the Highlander Auditorium. Attendance will be taken, please bring your ID Card.

CAP DECORATIONS

Students must adhere to the following guidelines:

- No part of the cap decoration should...
 - Threaten any person or group's safety
 - Be lewd, obscene, vulgar, or profane
 - Refer to controlled substances, weapons, or be of a sexual nature (includes advertisements, symbols, acronyms, slogans, pictures)
- Promote any gang affiliation
- Make noise
- **The cap decoration should also NOT be three-dimensional. It should lie flat on the top surface of the cap.**

Please note that you will not be given another cap if you do not like the decoration that you make for it. We would suggest practicing before creating the final decoration.

SPECIAL REGALIA

The California State Legislature has recently passed AB 1248, adding Education Code section 35183.1. This code allows students to wear "traditional tribal regalia or recognized objects of cultural or religious significance" at graduation ceremonies (emphasis added). These items must not cause a substantial disruption of or material interference with the ceremony. These are completely optional, and any student who chooses to wear one does so with the realization that it may cover all or some of any school-provided graduation regalia.

The Upland High School Administration reserves the right to disallow any cap decoration or item they deem to be objectionable; these will be confiscated and not returned.

COMMENCEMENT JUNE 8, 2023 AT 5:00 PM AT TOYOTA ARENA

Seniors must report to the Toyota Arena **no later than 3:30 p.m. attired in cap and gown**. There are no changing or storage areas at the Arena, so please come fully dressed and do not bring any items with you. Toyota Arena requires that all graduates and parents be searched by Arena security prior to entering. Graduates should not bring any items that may cause a distraction during the ceremony. No unauthorized items may be worn over the gown. Toyota Arena will not allow balloons, horns, wrapped gifts, and other items at their discretion into the Arena. Wrapped gifts will have the wrapping removed prior to entering the Arena or the item must remain in your vehicle.
