




Before Integrating with Realize	Notes
	<p>Your G Suite for Education account should be ready for use. Talk to your district or school for more information if you need help accessing a G Suite for Education account.</p>
	<p>Create a Google Classroom by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Navigating to classroom.google.com</li> <li>• Login with your G Suite for Education (Google) credentials</li> <li>• Click the + button at the top right hand side of the page and then click <b>Create class</b></li> </ul>

 <p>Mr. Rogers 4th Grade </p>	<p>NOTE: An alternative to adding students to a class is by sharing the Class Code listed on the Class Card with students. You can easily display the Class Code by clicking on the  icon.</p>
<p><b>Join class</b></p> <p>Ask your teacher for the class code, then enter it here.</p> <p>Class code</p> <p>Cancel Join</p>	<p>Students would then navigate to classroom.google.com =&gt; click on + button =&gt; <b>Join Class</b> and enter the code.</p>

	<p>Login to Savvas Realize by using the steps given to you by your district or school, e.g., by clicking on the Savvas Easybridge link on your District Website OR District Clever Portal OR Classlink Portal OR ...</p>
	<p>Connect your Google Classroom by logging into Savvas Realize.</p> <p>Click on the  in the upper right hand corner of the page.</p> <p>Click on <b>Settings</b></p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> You MUST first add the applicable programs to your account by clicking on the <b>My Programs</b> tab.</p> <p>Scroll down to the applicable program, e.g., <b>enVisionmath 2020 Common Core Grade 4</b></p> <p> the box.</p> <p>Click <b>Save</b></p>
	<p>Next click back on the <b>Account</b> tab and scroll down until you see the <b>Account Linking</b> section.</p> <p>Click on <b>Get Started</b></p>

Click on **Classes** then **Students & Groups**

**NOTE 1:** Students will NOT show up under Students & Groups until they accept the invite to the class (see student flow). Check back after Students have accepted the invite.

**NOTE 2:** Once Students accept the invite, they will show up under Students & Groups. Next to their name you will see **Needs to Connect** until they navigate to Realize for the 1st time (see student flow).

- **Note:** If you do not see students that have purportedly accepted the invite, navigate back to **Classes** and click **Sync with Google** under the book icon.

If not already there, navigate back to the **Classes** Tab.

**NOTE:** If you are expecting ALL of your students / classes to navigate to Savvas Realize from Google Classroom, you may want to **Hide** your Savvas



	<p>Navigate back to Google Classroom and confirm the assignment(s) appear, e.g., <b>1-1: <i>Generalize Place Value Understanding =&gt; Numbers Through One Million: Convince Me!</i></b></p> <p><b>NOTE 1:</b> Your Google Classroom is now integrated with Realize. Rosters, Assignments, AND scores will now automatically sync.</p> <p><b>NOTE 2:</b> Only students in the Realize class at the time the assignment is created will receive the assignment to complete. Students who join the class after an assignment has been posted will need to have the assignment assigned to them separately.</p>
