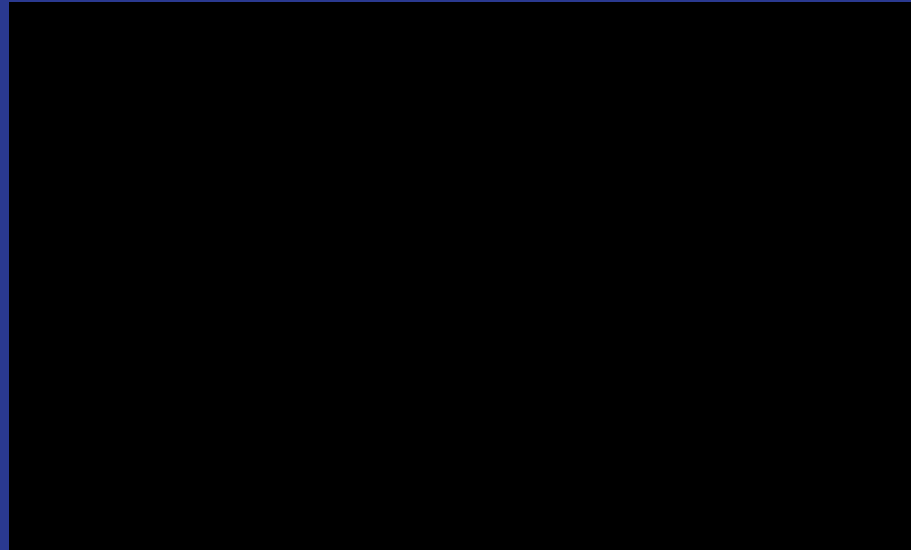

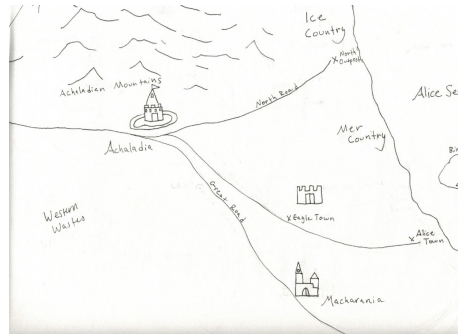


Dungeons And Dragons Club

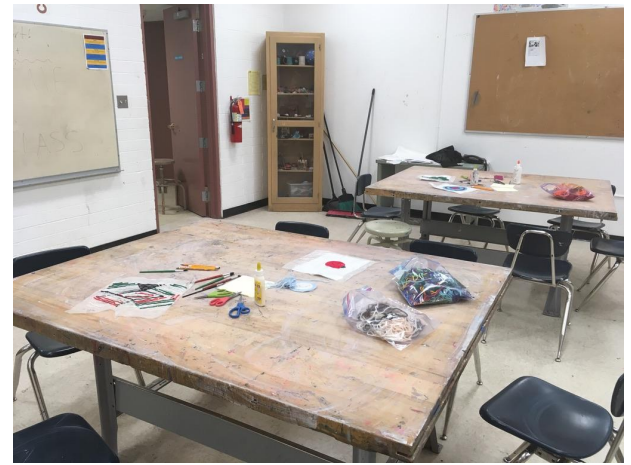
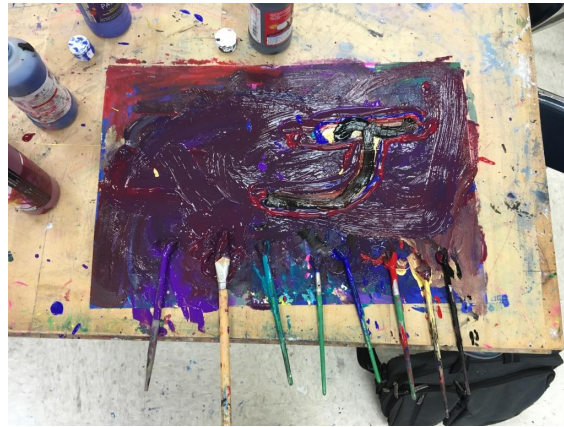
