The Board discussed a name for the Junior High School on the Reed Road. Mr. Potterf said he had heard rumors that the name of Chester T. Lane had been discussed. Leslie Fry said he thought it should be the Reed Road Junior High School because it has been the board's policy in the past, in naming senior and junior high schools, to pinpoint their locations such as Lakeside, Northwood, Fairfield, etc. President McNabb said the Board had departed from this when they named the senior high school, to be erected on the Reed Road, the R. Nelson Snider High School. Leslie Fry said he still thought they should pinpoint the location which the Board has done in the other junior high schools and bestow the names of persons on the elementary schools.

Arthur Meyer moved, seconded by Florence Buirley that the junior high school on the Reed Road be named the Chester T. Lane Junior High School. The motion was adopted by the following vote:
