Old business

Approval of 2021 SPSA Mr. Honey sent new copy to review over weekend. Are there any questions or comments?

Ms. Valdez – Were you able to get A-G enrollment clarification? No – there must be some system but it is not clear. If remove PE, etc, you would think A-G percentage would be higher. We need to know how this is measured so we can know how to get that percentage to move.

Ms. Valdez – In the past, Link Crew was allotted \$7000? Mr. Honey took out money to pay people to run this program from SPSA, now costs are just supplies for the kids.

Ms. Valdez – There are concern that leadership or the program is out of touch. Needs to be reviewed this year and make suggestions on going forward. Some of the activities are not helping to reach goal of creating community on the campus. Mr. Altschull will reach out to people at Boomerang Project, he will look into retraining. For example, the Balloon Crushing game between a boy and a girl. Many students in the audience and those chosen to participate were uncomfortable. Let's review the games. Even the Link Crew leaders were squished together in the MU, and asked to massage shoulders of person next to them. This is not appropriate, on many levels. The script needs to be adjusted modified.

Mr. Jenny – What are the Link Crew funds going? T-shirts and supplies from Office Depot. This year there were 400 Freshman in the program and 300 Sophomores, run on two separate days.

Ms. Valdez – Can there be a review regarding the amount of waste in link crew program? Don't just blindly follow the program, 5-10 reams of paper just thrown away. Can you report back in May about

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how the program will be adjusted? The program is ongoing throughout the year. We would like to hear how the students feel about it.

Mr. Jenny – Will ask friends on Link Crew about opinions.

Ms. Blandon – Various Sophomore friends found the program valuable to be introduced to the school.

Ms. Valdez – Please ask for feedback for students involved for Link Crew, and other programs.

Mr. Honey sends out surveys, but only gets a handful back. Would like to get hundreds.

Ms. Stroot - On page 3, section B mentions API, which is no longer used, now use CAASPP dashboard, should this be changed? Mr. Honey responded that this is something that is just automatically filled in, we cannot edit.

Ms. Stroot - On page 5, last two boxes in evaluation – 1.1 effective, but nothing under measurable data. 1.2 says none – not effective. Mr. Honey responded that teacher feedback liked it, but there is no formal data to measure. This could change but we need more time to evaluate.

Ms. Stroot - On page 6, 1.4, In a few boxes the teacher name is used. Should we just put their position in so next time we can cut and paste if they leave? Mr. Honey was trying to be clear, and if that happens this will be an easy fix.

Ms. Stroot - On page 10 data in the 2 boxes are the same. Mr. Honey responded that because we have no data. Couldn't do the CA Healthy Kids Survey last year due to COVID.

Ms. Stroot - On page 28 counselors will identify student needs and resources. . Mr. Honey responded that this is a bad edit . What actions and services address that need? The Wellness Center redesign will allow more space, and need more adults. The counselors are swamped. Want counselor to identify need and put the students into program for support.

Ms. Valdez – does every student see a counselor every year. Mr. Honey - Seen everyone in groups. Now it is targeted with college application lunch.

Ms. Valdez – Is the Wellness Center connected to academic counselors? Mr. Honey responded that they connect all the time to Wellness Center. This is not a financial obligation so we can't track this. In a crisis situation lots of people who work together to help.

Mr. Honey - CPHS is not identified as a population that needs Mental Health crisis help by the District. He is asking urgently to get more support.

Ms. Stroot – Do students self identify? All the time, there are lines coming out of the Wellness Center. Counselors reach out as well. Students come, or their friends come.

Ms. Stroot – Regarding Tea with Honey, are these recorded or notes for those who cannot attend? Mr. Honey has sent agenda and key talking points in the past and will make a point to do so.

Ms. Valdez – Can we get info this year for ongoing funding, such as the TOSA positions? What are they doing, what is the metric? Mr Honey will arrange for them to speak in SSC later this year, maybe February meeting have the TOSA RTI report.
