Wanted to have a calming, welcoming environment. 50% from 0930 money to support, hoping to get other 50% from district. Now Ms. Segee can supervise the entire program, and they are able to get more support people. We are thrilled with how fast coming together.

Mr. Jenny – Did not know about the Wellness Center before SSC. Would like more communication about the hours to the student body. Many students are not aware about the Wellness Center or when they can go there.

Ms. Blandon – Good addition because many struggling with mental health. Did not know about before SSC this year.

### **Student Updates**

Mr. Jenny – Not have much to report. We are in the home stretch now. Many of peers are tired. Twenty-five school days left. AP tests coming up. We are winding down for the school year. Question from Mr. Honey? What do you see for the fall? Mask mandate gone, not much social distancing. Seems pretty close to normal. He thinks it will go more to normal.

Ms. Blandon – Waiting for the school year to wrap up.

Ms. Hatch – nice to see smiling faces. People look different without masks.

### **School Updates – Mr. Honey:**

#### **COVID**

Open House tonight, but do not have the eighth graders. This is the first time that many parents have really been on campus in 2 years.

Less than five cases of COVID over the Spring Break

CPHS still have 140,000 masks. Received right at the end of January, when things were winding down.

#### **Enrollment**

8<sup>th</sup> graders coming in (projected) 528 students

9<sup>th</sup> graders 500 students

10<sup>th</sup> graders 535 students

11<sup>th</sup> graders 450 students

12<sup>th</sup> graders 481 students

Projected for next year: 1966 total students

#### **Staffing**

We have had 3 layoffs, 2 teachers resigning, and 1 retirement

Hoping to get all the 3 layoffs back, we need to inform them by next Friday.

We hope to bring back all 5 positions to CPHS

Master schedule is in process – due to teachers by 4/29/22

School begins August 11, and the walk through will probably be August 3, 4, and 5

### Questions?

Ms. Valdez – Regarding today’s fire incident, were people identified and how will they be held accountable? Administration has narrowed down to the person of interest, and a multi-day suspension will probably be the most that can happen. Had a hard time clearing the alarm because the smoke wouldn’t clear. This was a major school disruption. The bathroom will function by next week.

Ms. Valdez – When can we expect year books? These should arrive on time. They will make a distribution plan once they arrive. They need to be distributed before May 26, when seniors graduate.

Ms. Valdez – When is the date for student government elections? Per the ASB Constitution, elections are supposed to be held 60 days before the end of the term, but that time has passed. Ms. Hatch is in charge of this program. There are only two contested elections. Ms. Valdez wanted to be sure they included a write-in option on any Google voting ballots as the Constitution allows for write-in candidates and they have not done that in the past. Ms. Hatch noted that anyone running for ASB President needed to have a minimum of one year leadership experience, however Ms. Valdez clarified that was not a requirement for other ASB and class officer positions. Class officers also need to be in leadership class. Concerns expressed that CPHS ASB Constitution is not being followed and want it to be more democratic and inclusive. This is a good learning opportunity for our students to participate in the democratic form of government.
