



UNITY SCHOOLS



Academic Emphasis

- Tier 1: Standards based core instruction with supports and enhancements
- Tier 2: Targeted instruction
- Tier 3: Personalized plan for intensive instruction



Readiness to Learn Emphasis

- Tier 1: Foundation of grade level appropriate emotional, social, and behavioral expectations for all with supports
- Tier 2: Targeted interventions
- Tier 3: Personalized plan for intensive intervention



Guidance and Counseling Program

- Foundational shift to a proactive data informed comprehensive guidance and counseling program
- Backbone of the Pyramid for Success™
- Standards-based curriculum, individual planning, responsive services, system (program) support



Program Integration

- Identified students included in all three tiers
- English Language Learners
- High Ability
- Special Education




Tier 1 Supports

- Academic and readiness-to-learn social, emotional, and behavioral supports are provided in addition to the foundation for all
- Supports are based on identified student needs
- Supports are implemented before student support team meetings



Pyramid for Success[™] Problem Solving Model



This problem solving process is designed to facilitate movement through the Pyramid in a fluid, flexible manner. The cycle is ongoing as long as concerns about student progress continue.

- Selection criteria for approved Tier 2 targeted instruction and targeted interventions
- Tier 2 targeted responses Include
 - Peer reviewed research base
 - Protocol for implementation
 - Fidelity check

Tier 3 Intensive Personalized Plans

- Addition to or alternative to Tiers 1 & 2 per personalized plan
- Plan developed through student support team problem solving process
