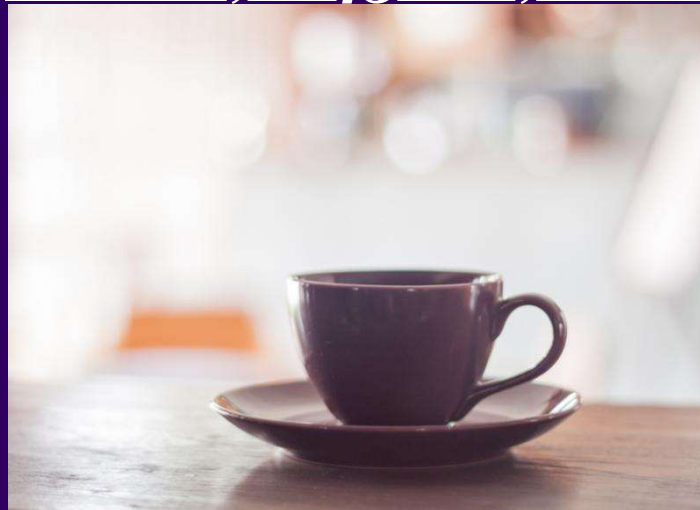

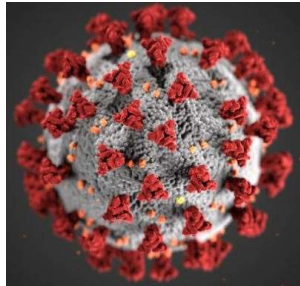

 - Do not eat, drink, or smoke within 20 minutes of the test.
 - Once all forms have been confirmed and submitted, a registered nurse will assist you with the test.
 - Tests are done with oral swab in your mouth. You will do this yourself under supervision.
